# Four anchors of activity

#### **Commercial Tenants**

Nearly 40,000 SF of state-of-the-art facilities where life science and health care innovators turn their discoveries into high-performing ventures, and establishing it as the epicenter for regional life science innovation. In 2024, Pegasus Park plans to deliver Bridge Labs, 135,000 square feet of additional lab and office space.


#### **Water Cooler**








# Typical Floorplan



Access to every major city in the continental U.S. within 4 hours.


### **Airline Hub**




