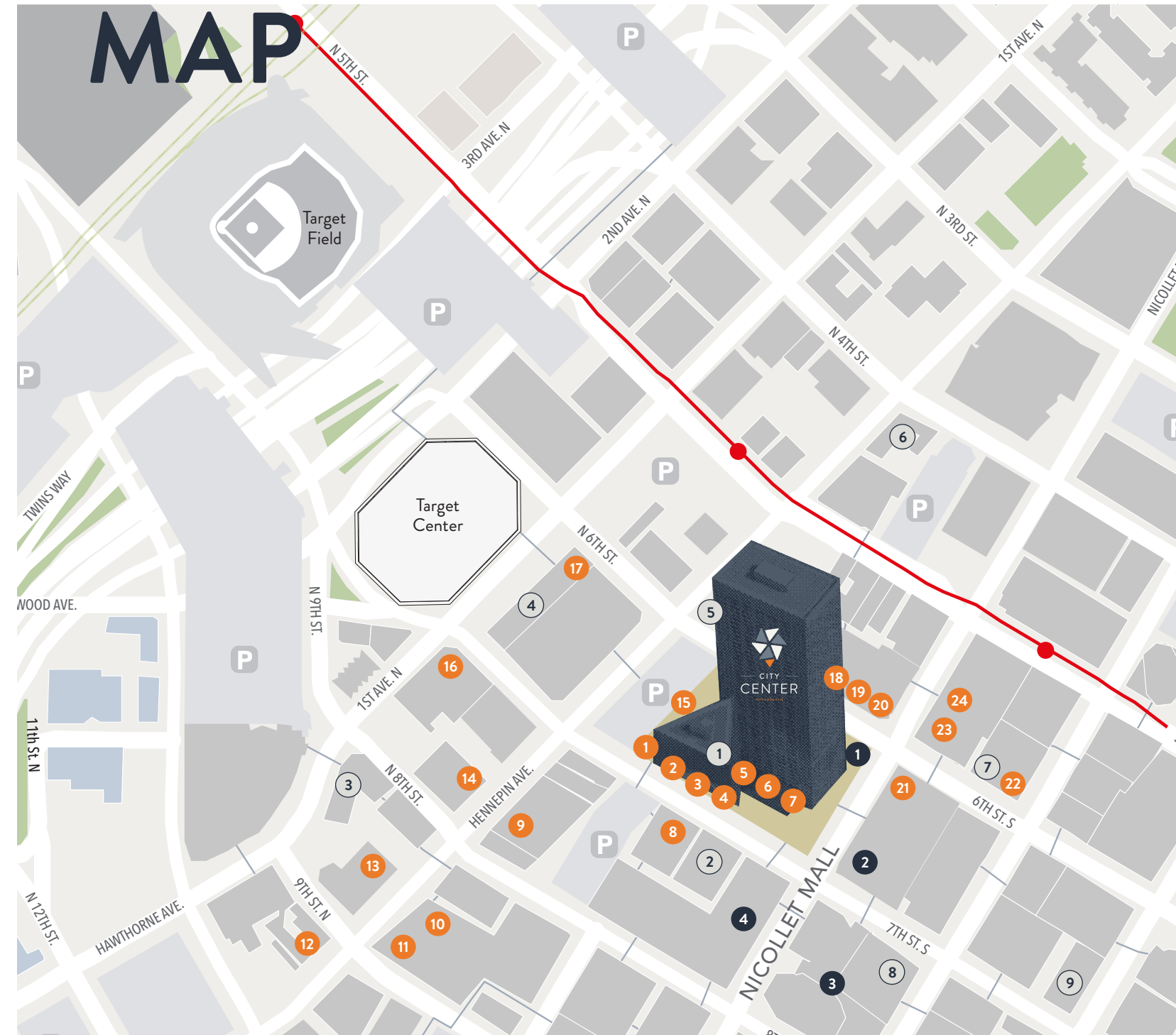
### Transit:

City Center is centrally located to numerous public transportation options. The Nicollet Mall Light Rail station is one block from the property, offering service to 19 stations between downtown Minneapolis and Mall of America via the Hiawatha Line. Further, there are over 32 bus routes with stops within one block. Bike storage room available for tenants.

### Security:

The building lobby, elevators and parking garage are accessible on a 24 hour basis and are equipped with a key card access system. Full time on-site security personnel patrol the Building and parking garage seven days a week. The garage, ramp, loading dock and remote access halls are monitored by digital video.
