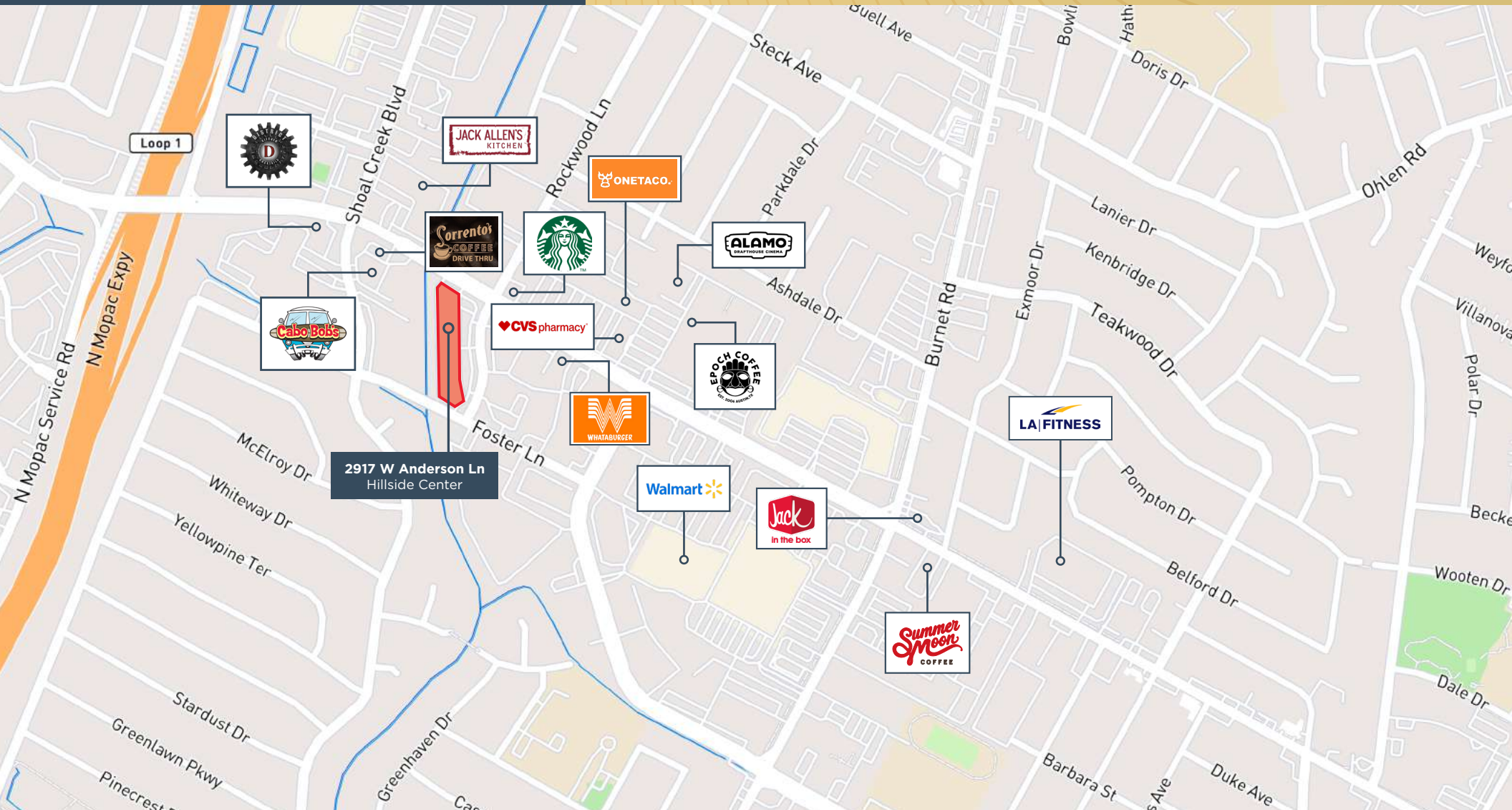

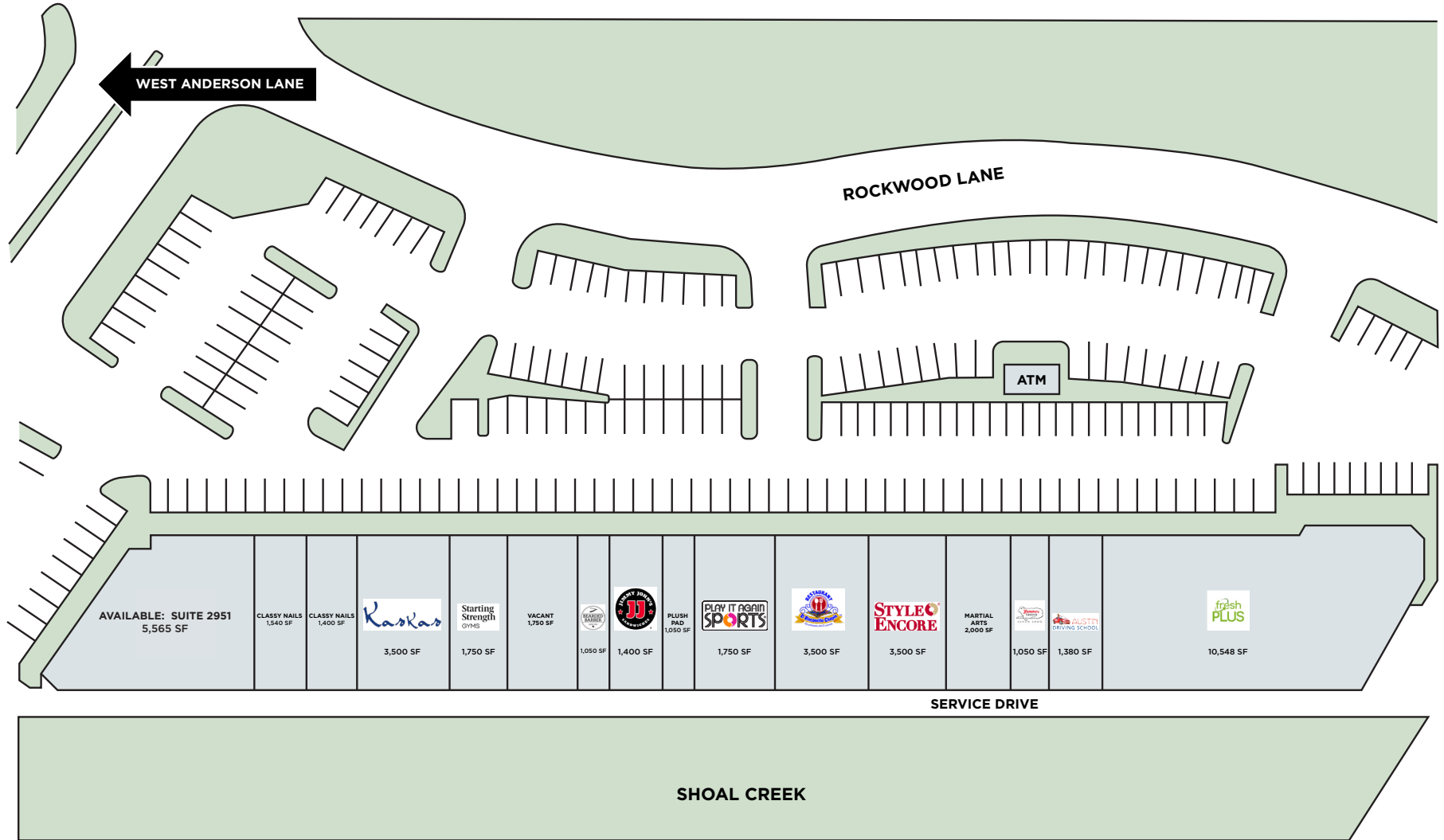

In the identified area, the current year population is 330,592. In 2020, the Census count in the area was 325,313. The rate of change since 2020 was 0.50% annually. The five-year projection for the population in the area is 336,249 representing a change of 0.34% annually from 2023 to 2028. Currently, the population is 51.3% male and 48.7% female.

Current median household income is \$75,060 in the area, compared to \$72,603 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$83,218 in five years, compared to \$82,410 for all U.S. households

Currently, 36.0% of the 161,996 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 55.6%, renter occupied; and 8.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.5% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.7% are renter occupied; and 9.8% are vacant. In 2020, there were 155,514 housing units in the area and 7.7% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 1.26%. Median home value in the area is \$576,581, compared to a median home value of \$308,943 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.08% annually to \$578,853.

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
