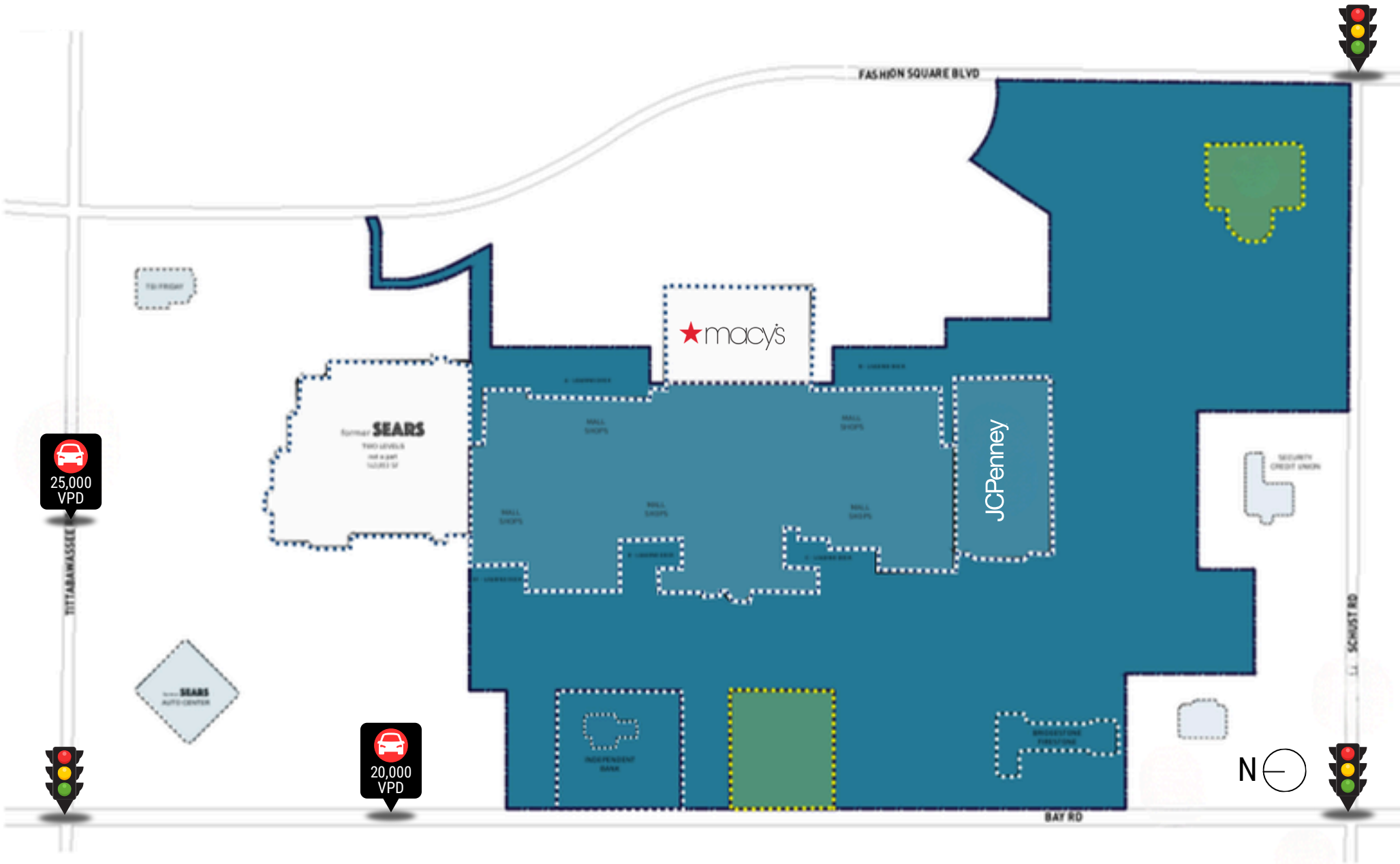
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SITE AERIAL

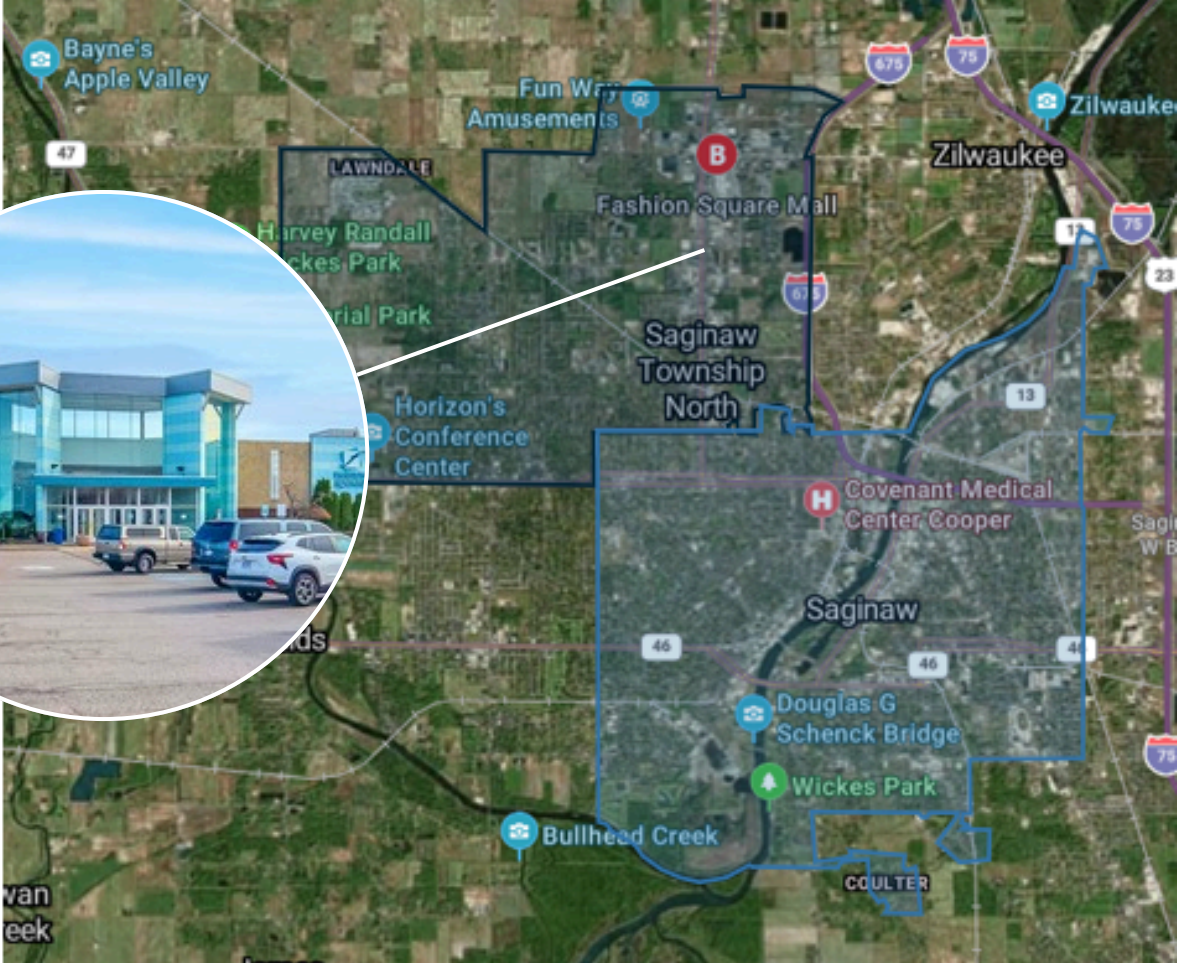


SITE PLAN

SAGINAW, MICHIGAN

The City of Saginaw sits along the Saginaw River in central Saginaw County and serves as a major community within Michigan’s Great Lakes Bay Region. Its location near I-75 and M-46 provides easy access to nearby townships and regional destinations. The city features a mix of historic neighborhoods, suburban areas, commercial districts, and long-established industrial zones.

Saginaw blends small-city charm with a range of cultural and recreational amenities, including the Temple Theatre, Castle Museum, Saginaw Art Museum, and the Dow Event Center. Nearby institutions like Saginaw Valley State University and Delta College enhance the area’s educational and cultural landscape.

Major medical centers also contribute to job growth. With its central location and strong industrial base, Saginaw remains an important economic hub in Mid-Michigan.
