

Owner's Work Letter for Office Space

The base rent rate quoted in this proposal includes the following scope of work. Please review these terms carefully because there is no such thing as a "standard" work letter.

Walls and Partitions

- Tenant receives fifty (50) linear feet of partition wall per 3,000 sq ft of space.
- Demising walls between different Tenant spaces will be full height insulated one-hour fire separation using six inch steel studs and 5/8" drywall.
- Interior tenant partitions will be 3 5/8" steel studs with 5/8" 24" center drywall on each side built to the underside of the ceiling.

Ceilings and Light Fixtures

- Ceilings will be 2' x 4' second look lay-in tile with a reveal suspended acoustical ceiling tile on an exposed metal grid at nine feet above finished floor.
- Tenant receives one lighting fixture per 100 sq ft of finished office space.
- Light fixtures will be recessed 2' x 4' LED lights.

Flooring

- Six (6) inch non-reinforced concrete floor.
- Vinyl laminate with vinyl base in the washrooms, break room and entrance area as well as offices. No flooring to be installed in mechanical rooms or warehouse areas.

Painting

- All drywall surfaces will be painted with one latex primer coat and one latex finish coat.
- Tenant receives one color for the office.

Doors and Hardware

• Interior tenant doors will be 1 \% " x 3' 0" x 7' 0" hollow core pre finished.

Electrical Service

• Each Tenant space will receive a distribution panel 200 amp and plugs and switches to code.

Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC)

- Owner provides gas fired roof top units with economizers and programmable thermostats designed to maintain the following conditions with (i) a maximum density factor of one person per 200 sq ft, and (ii) the electrical distribution provided:
 - Winter 70 degrees with a dry bulb of +/- 2 degrees
 - o Summer 74 degrees with a dry bulb of +/- 2 degrees
- Each washroom receives a ventilation fan
- Cooling requirements for computer server room and other special uses are not included.

Plumbing, Toilet Fixtures, and Washroom Finishes

• Owner provides ADA complaint washrooms sufficient in size for the office area per code.

Fire Protection

• The office has fire protection that meets ordinary hazard class one
