Spruill Ave Revitalization
Over the past five years, new businesses, restaurants and craft beverage producers have located to Spruill Avenue including The Junction, Holy City Brewery, Roadside Blooms, The Station and Jackrabbit Filly.

East Montague Business Dist.



The heart of Park Circle's dining and entertainment scene is on East Montague, including neighborhood favorites like EVO Pizza, Basil, Madra Rua and the Orange Spot Coffeehouse.

N. Charleston Riverfront Park



Opened in 2005, this 15-acre park includes a boardwalk along the Cooper River, fishing pier, dog park and outdoor amphitheater. The park is home to the region's largest 4th of July Festival and most sought after Music Festivals.

Former Navy Yard



Closed in 1996, the former Charleston Naval Base has undergone a resurgence and remains an established economic engine for the region. The property is home to over 125 employers and 6,500 daytime employees.
