Overview | Shop Grove Industrial Park

The Shop Grove Industrial Park is located at Ranger Point Court & Sparkman Drive in Columbia, South Carolina near Shop Road & I-77 (Exit 5 & Exit 6). The Park consists of a ±217,000 SF warehouse and several undeveloped sites. Site 01 (±5.79 acres) and Site 02 (±7.49 acres) are available for purchase or build-to-suit.



CENTRALIZED ACCESS TO MAJOR HIGHWAYS | The Park is near I-77, which connects Columbia, SC to Charlotte, NC, and provides direct access to I-20 (east-west) and I-26 (north-south). These major highways create efficient transportation routes for goods moving to and from regional markets and major distribution hubs such as:

- Columbia Metropolitan Airport (CAE) (±15 minutes)
- Greenville - Spartanburg Airport (GSP) & the SC Inland Port-Greer (±1.5 hours)
- SC Port of Charleston (±2 hours)
- Atlanta, GA (±3 hours)



INDUSTRIAL CLUSTER PROXIMITY | Columbia is home to a growing industrial and logistics hub, with major companies in automotive, manufacturing, and distribution. Nearby industrial businesses include PODS Moving & Storage, Mygrant Glass Co, 84 Lumber, Renewal by Anderson, Technetics Group, TMC Transportation, Excel Truck Group, Rinker Materials, Jushi USA, Mark Anthony Brewing, FedEx Ground (distribution site) and the Park is located ±20 miles from the new Scout manufacturing facility.



SKILLED WORKFORCE | The area's industrial base is supported by a skilled and growing workforce, partly driven by the presence of Midlands Technical College and the University of South Carolina, which offer workforce development programs geared toward manufacturing, logistics, and engineering



AFFORDABILITY COMPARED TO MAJOR METRO AREAS | Industrial real estate and labor costs in Columbia are generally more affordable than in Charlotte, Greenville, or Charleston, making it an attractive option for companies looking to optimize their operating expenses while staying close to major markets






Submarket Map | Shop Grove Industrial Park
