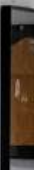




Capitalism in Color – Iconic Trading Jackets

Trading jackets worn in the Chicago Board of Trade Building were not just articles of clothing; they were symbols of status, expertise, and tradition in the fast-paced world of commodity trading.
