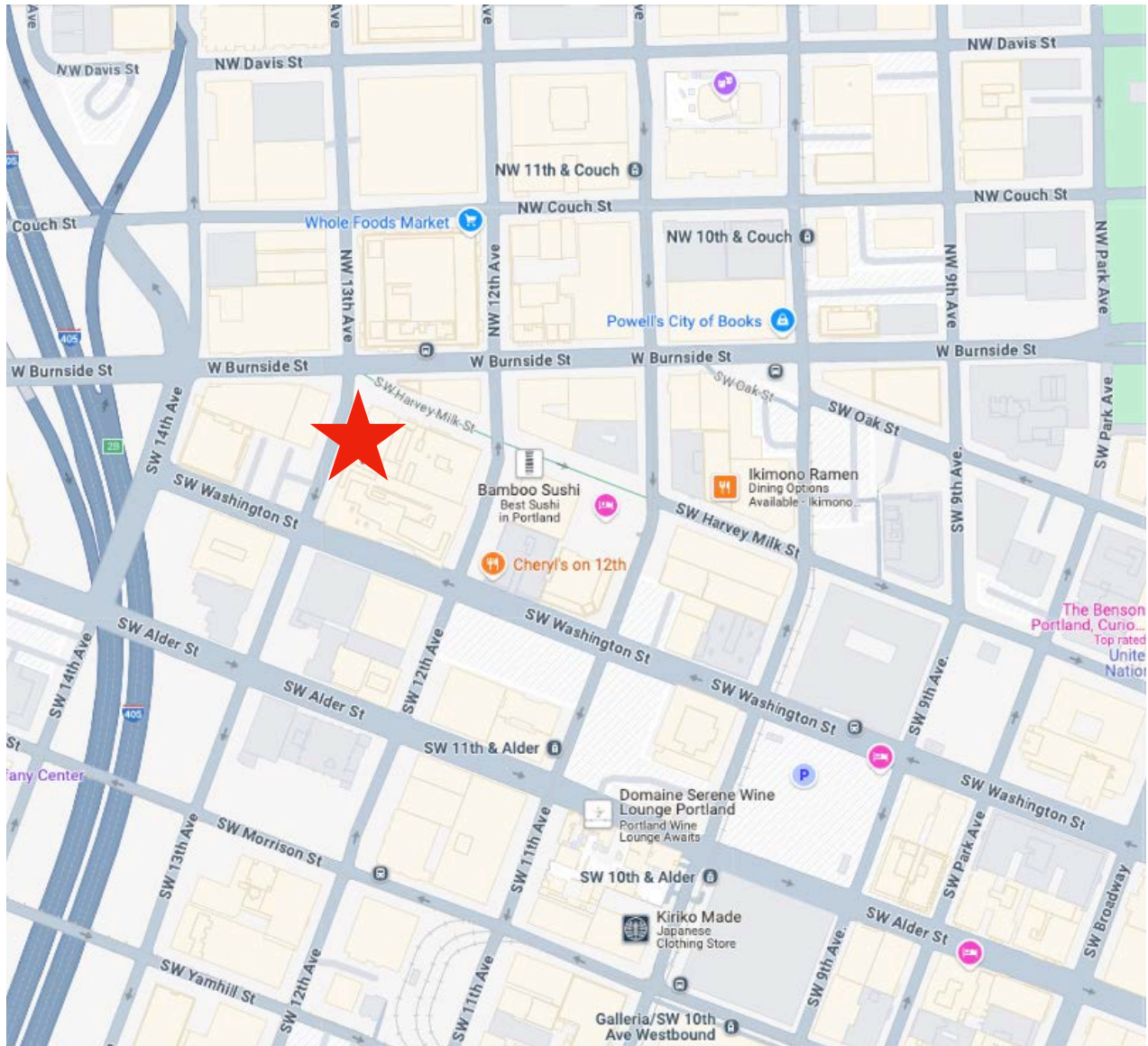

Net worth measures total household assets (homes, vehicles, investments, etc.) less any debts, secured (e.g. mortgages) or unsecured (credit cards) for this area.

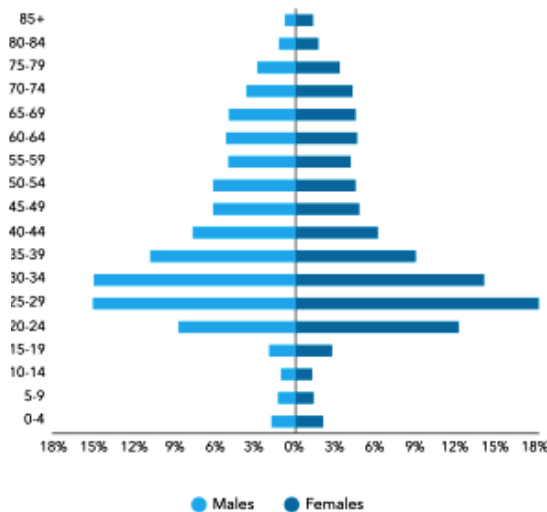

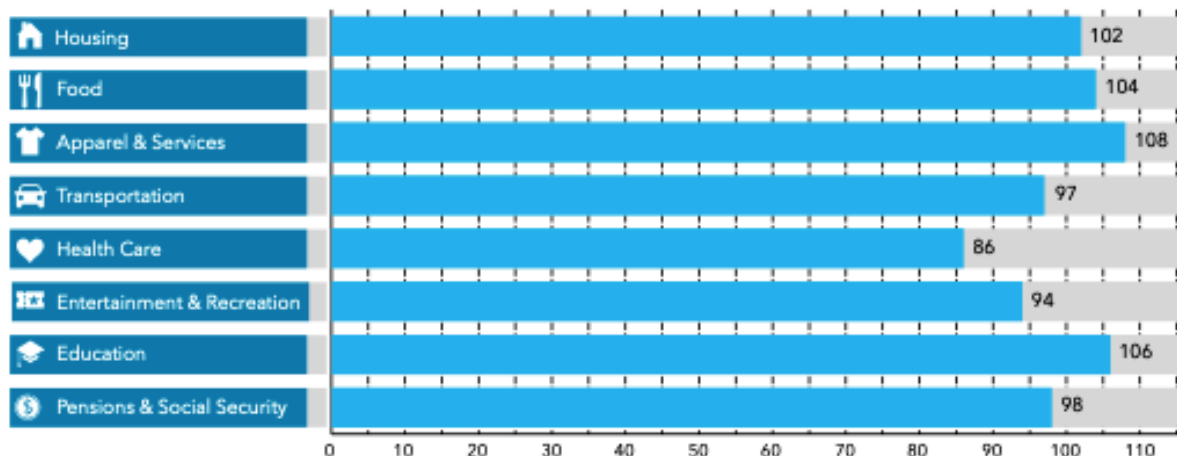
