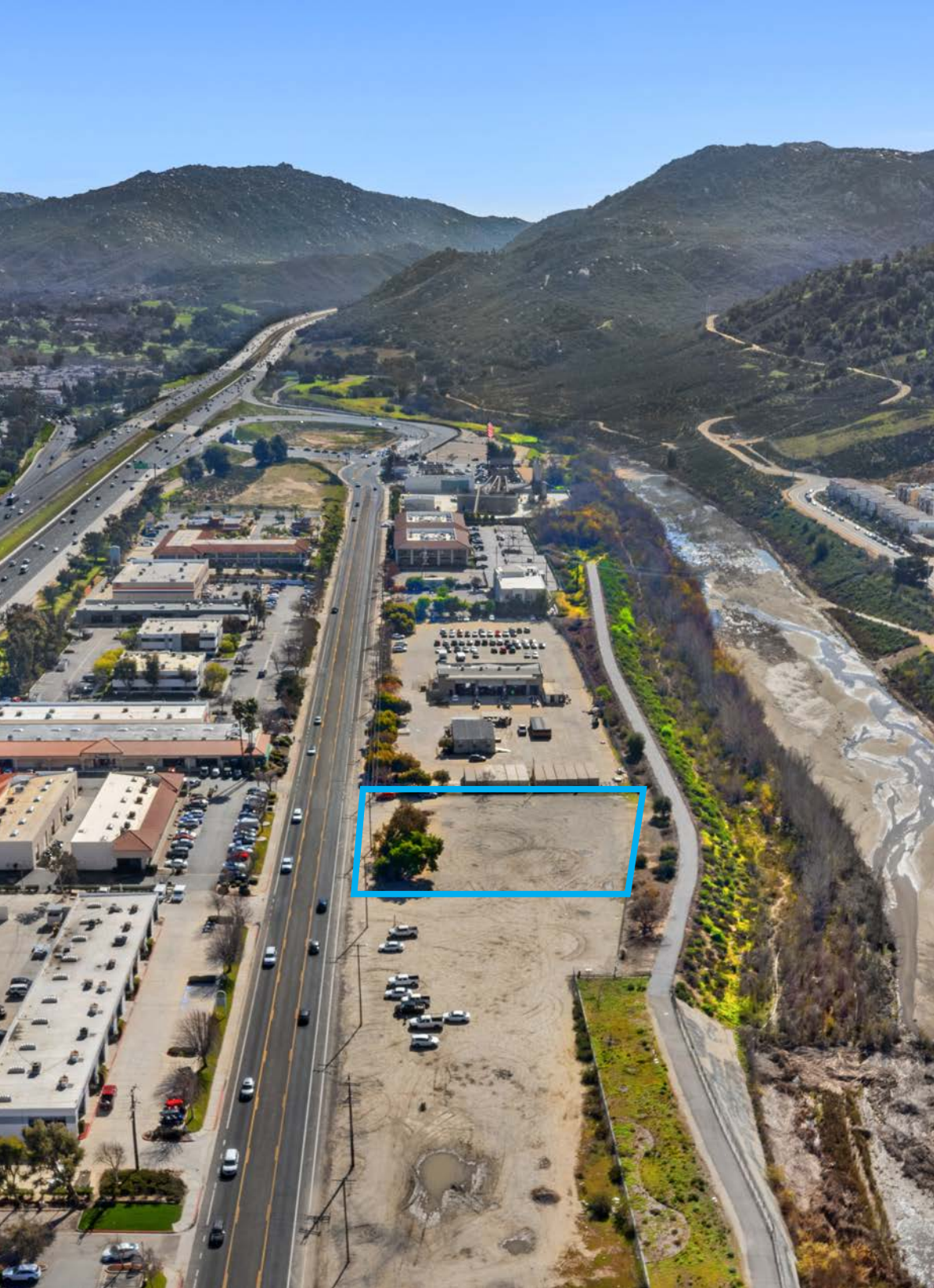

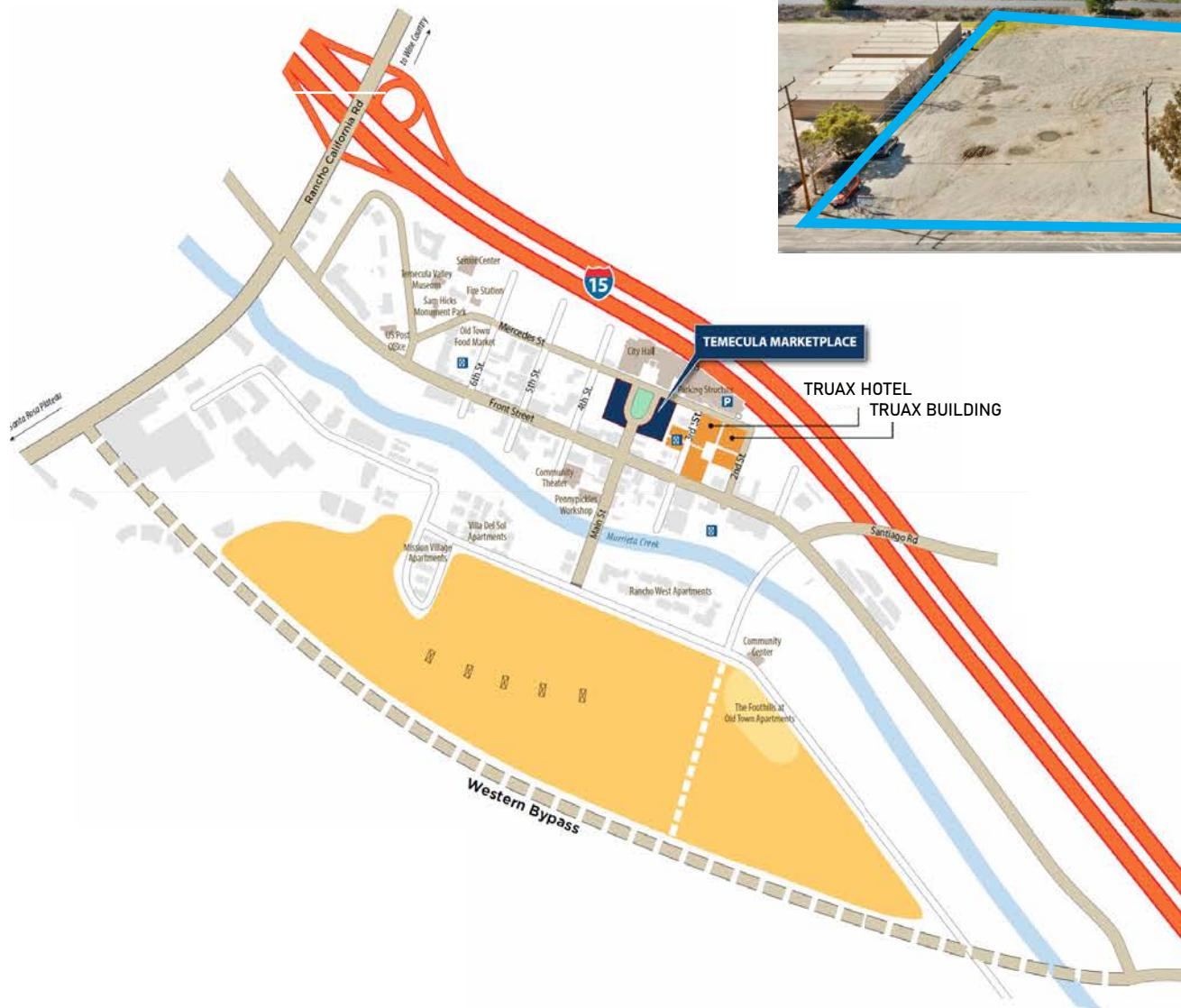
PARCEL MAP & ZONING

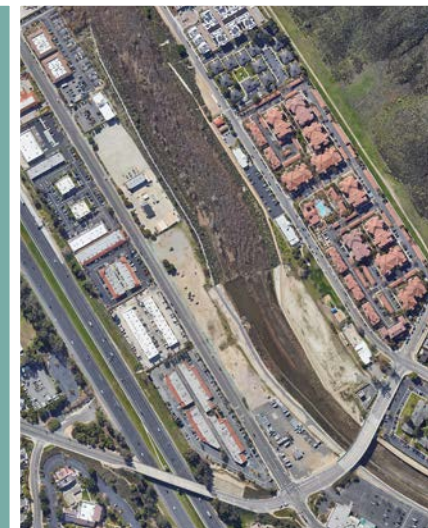

ABOUT TEMECULA

Located about an hour north of San Diego and two hours South of Los Angeles, there are few regions more accessible from city centers than Temecula Valley. This Tuscan-like wine region is within a one-to-two-hour drive from most of Southern California's major cities and airports, making it an ideal Wine Country getaway for SoCal natives, or those traveling to bigger cities like San Diego, Palm Springs, and Los Angeles.

Just 22 miles inland from the Pacific Ocean, Temecula Valley is not just a great place to vacation; it's home to the perfect Mediterranean climate in which to grow grapes. The region is bordered by coastal mountain ranges and inland valleys. As the sun warms the valleys east of Temecula, the warm air rises, forming a low-pressure area which pulls the cooler, much heavier air from the Pacific Ocean in through two breaks in the mountains — the Rainbow Gap and the Santa Margarita Gap. This cool air creates the pattern of warm sunny days, breezy afternoons, and cool nights, resulting in ideal conditions for the wine grapes to develop complex flavors and aromas, while retaining pleasant balance and freshness from desirable acidity levels.



OLD TOWN TEMECULA



Old Town Temecula combines the region's storied past and its exciting up-and-coming future in a unique blend of shops, restaurants, hotels, entertainment, and event opportunities in one walkable, easy-to-navigate hub for visitors to explore.

Take a step back in time with wooden boardwalks that pass rustic western-era buildings, antique shops, and specialty boutiques featuring Temecula-made artisan goods, or explore the most up-to-date trends including sampling pints at craft breweries, attending outdoor festivals, grabbing a bite of local, farm-to-table dining, or dancing to live music at bars and unique outdoor venues.

History buffs can wander the streets of Old Town Temecula viewing rustic buildings, sidewalks, and storefronts reminiscent of our historic golden west in the 1880s.



Since the turn of this current century, western-themed Old Town Temecula has solidified its position as the heart and soul of this booming Riverside County community known as the Temecula Valley. Weekend nights this district transforms into a thriving and lively center for food and live entertainment. Saturdays are especially vibrant, highlighted by a year-round morning Farmer's Market, with a variety of special events and festivals on many weekends throughout the year.

Rural in nature, sustainable in farming practices and including an agricultural preserve known as the Citrus/Vineyard zone, the Temecula Valley is widely recognized as the 'jewel' of Riverside County. Temecula Wine Country is centrally located just east of Interstate 15.

Along with fabulous wines, you'll find incredible winery restaurants, intimate bed and breakfast inns, lush resorts, splendid gift shops and beautiful picnic grounds.

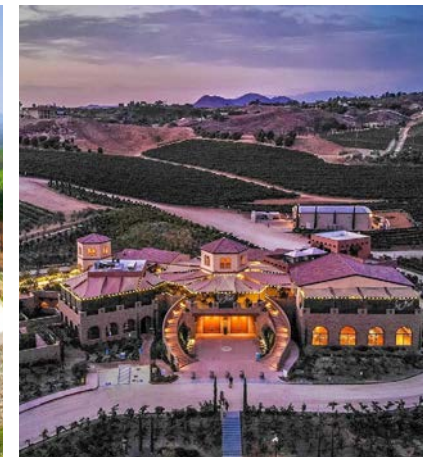
Promenade Temecula is a fashion and lifestyle shopping destination offering the best and largest mix of stores, restaurants and entertainment in the Temecula Valley.
