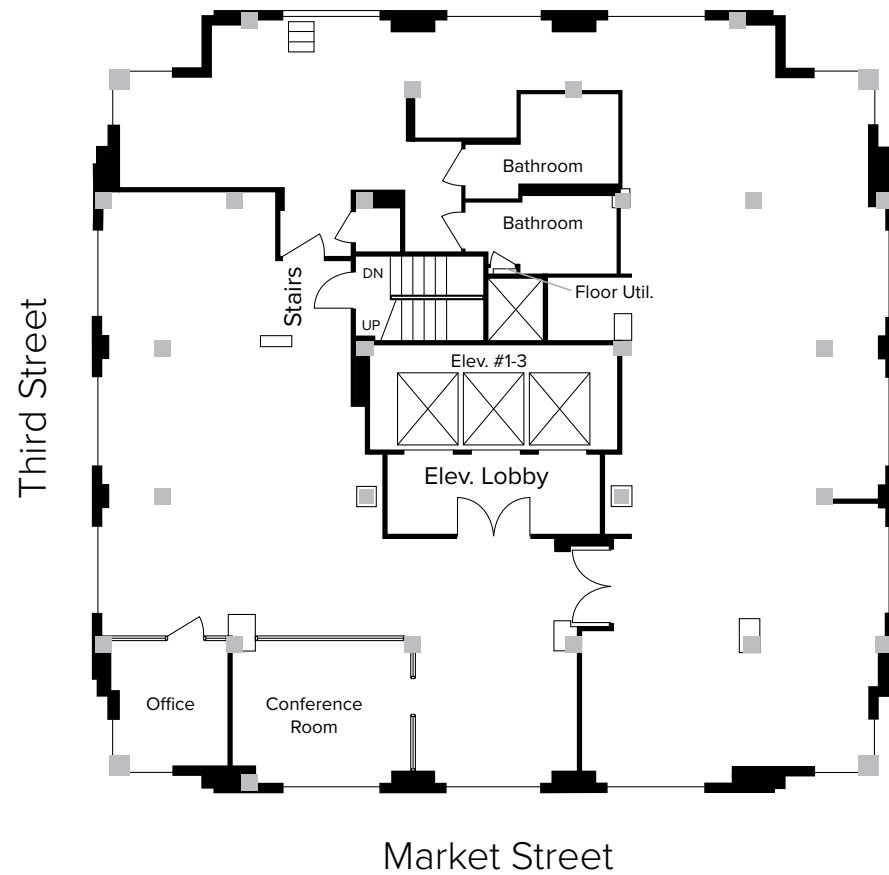

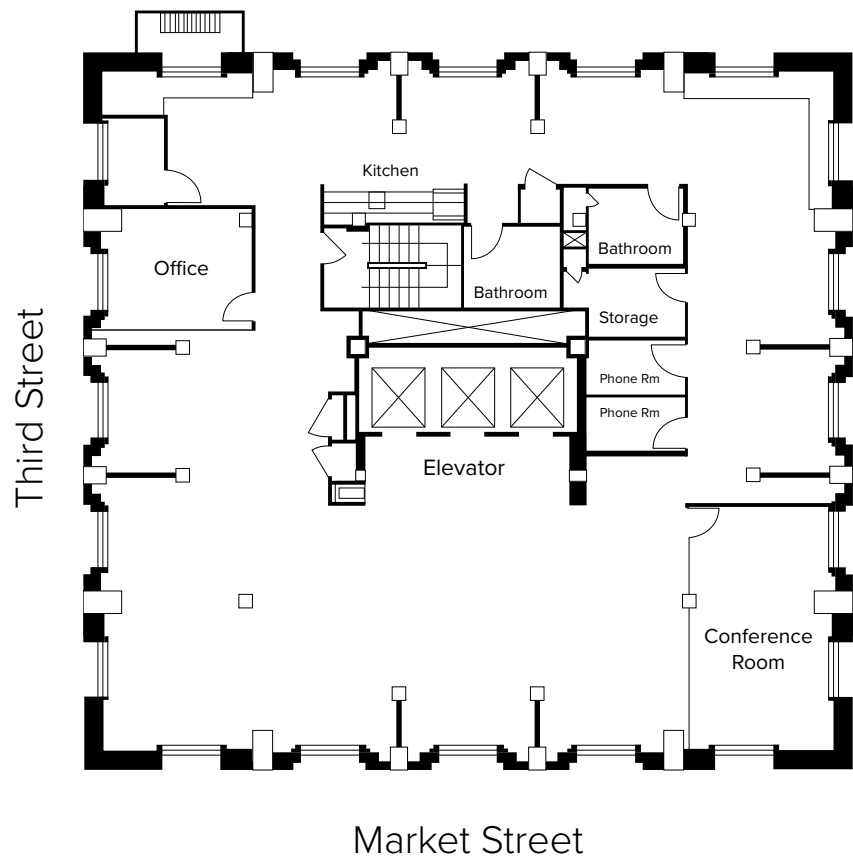

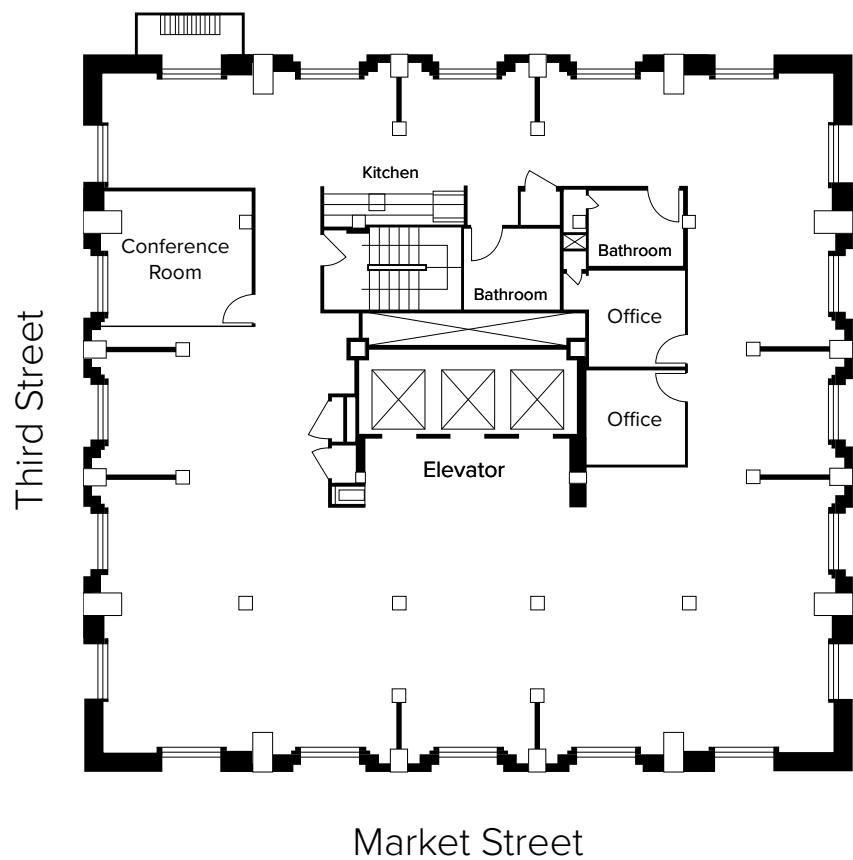

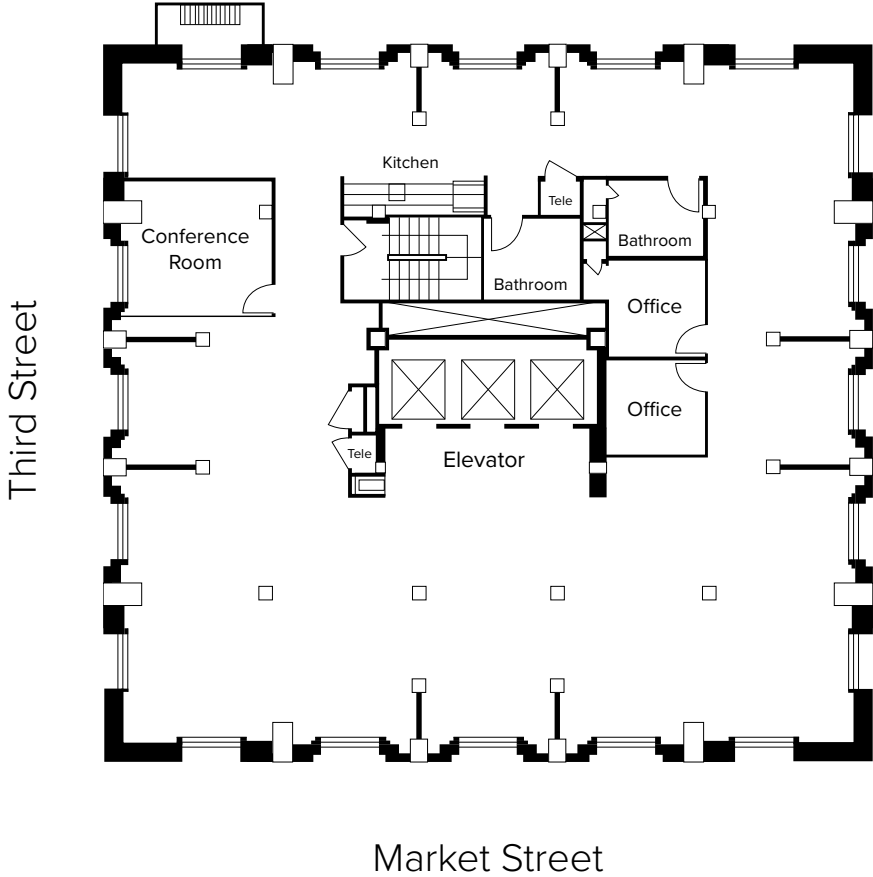

A Legacy of Modernization

703 Market is a distinguished landmark in San Francisco's history. It has been known by a few names as one of the city's first skyscrapers. Once known as the "Call Building", then as "Central Tower". This building has witnessed over a century of San Francisco's progress. 703 Market is a symbol of the city's history of ingenuity & innovation.



BUILDING HISTORY

- ◆ Built-in 1897 by entrepreneur and civic leader Claus Spreckels.
- ◆ Withstood The Great 1906 Earthquake.
- ◆ At 315 ft tall, the building was the tallest office building west of Chicago.
- ◆ In 1937, architect Albert Roller completely refurbished the building, removing the distinctive dome and adding six more floors of office space; bringing the height down to 298 ft.
- ◆ In 2014 –2015 the building was fully repositioned by CIM.
