BECINNINC at a set 5/8" rod for N.E. corner hereof, with said rod and corner being distant, S. 09°08'00" W. a distance of 50.0 feet from the S.E. corner of Lot No. 8 of Block No. 2 of "Los Olmos" Addition in Porcion Nos. 80-81, Camargo Jurisdiction, Starr County, Texas;

THENCE S. 09' 10'19" W., a distance of 385.55 feet to a found 1/2" rod, for S.E. corner hereof; THENCE N. 44' 09'00" W., a distance of 216.18 feet to a found 1/2" rod for S.W. corner hereof;

THENCE N. 09'08'00" E., a distance of 256.30 feet to a found 1/2" rod for N.W. corner hereof;

THENCE S. 80 52'00" E., a distance of 173.55 feet to the place of BECINNING and containing within these metes and bounds, a 1.28 Acre parcel of land, more or less.
