DEVELOPMENT OVERVIEW

Highland Bridge will feature over 55 acres of public and open space, office and retail space, and residential options including affordable housing, senior living, market-rate apartments, single-family, condos and rowhomes.

Gathering spaces throughout the development will attract and engage the community. Iconic features and amenities will create a distinct sense of place, built upon the spirit of Saint Paul. This mixed-use development provides something for everyone and reasons to visit and revisit this special place.







































SUSTAINABILITY



Electricity will be available from 100% carbon free and renewable sources and the Twin Cities largest urban solar array.



Larger buildings will be solar-ready and LEED or B3 Certified, as well as comply with SB 2030 and the St. Paul Sustainable Building Policy.



Stormwater in Highland Bridge will be collected for onsite treatment including the creative reuse of stormwater in the project's central water feature.



A minimum of a hundred electric vehicle charging stations will be onsite, and the entries of all buildings will be within a quarter mile of public transit













Highland Bridge's stormwater strategy also reconnects and rejuvenates Hidden Falls Creek, which was buried and paved over prior to construction of the original Ford plant.

More than a thousand non-invasive trees and native landscaping selections will be planted, that will offer changes from season to season. Predicted landscaping will use 50% less water than a traditionally irrigated site
