Join a strong mix of national retailers including Home Depot, Tim Horton's, 7-11, and Petro Canada.

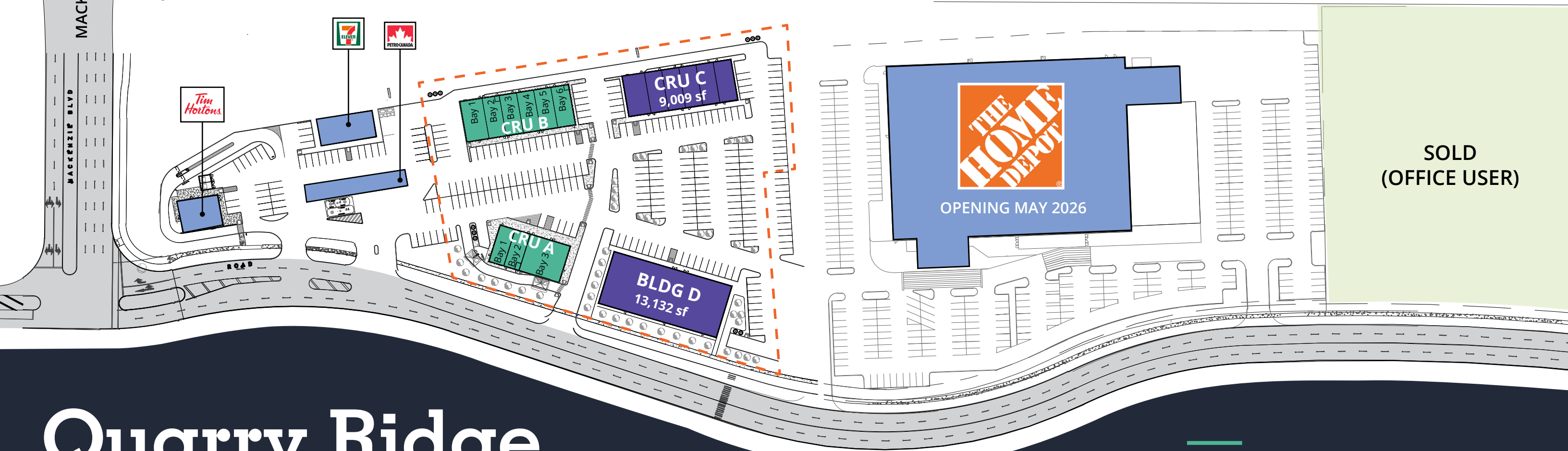

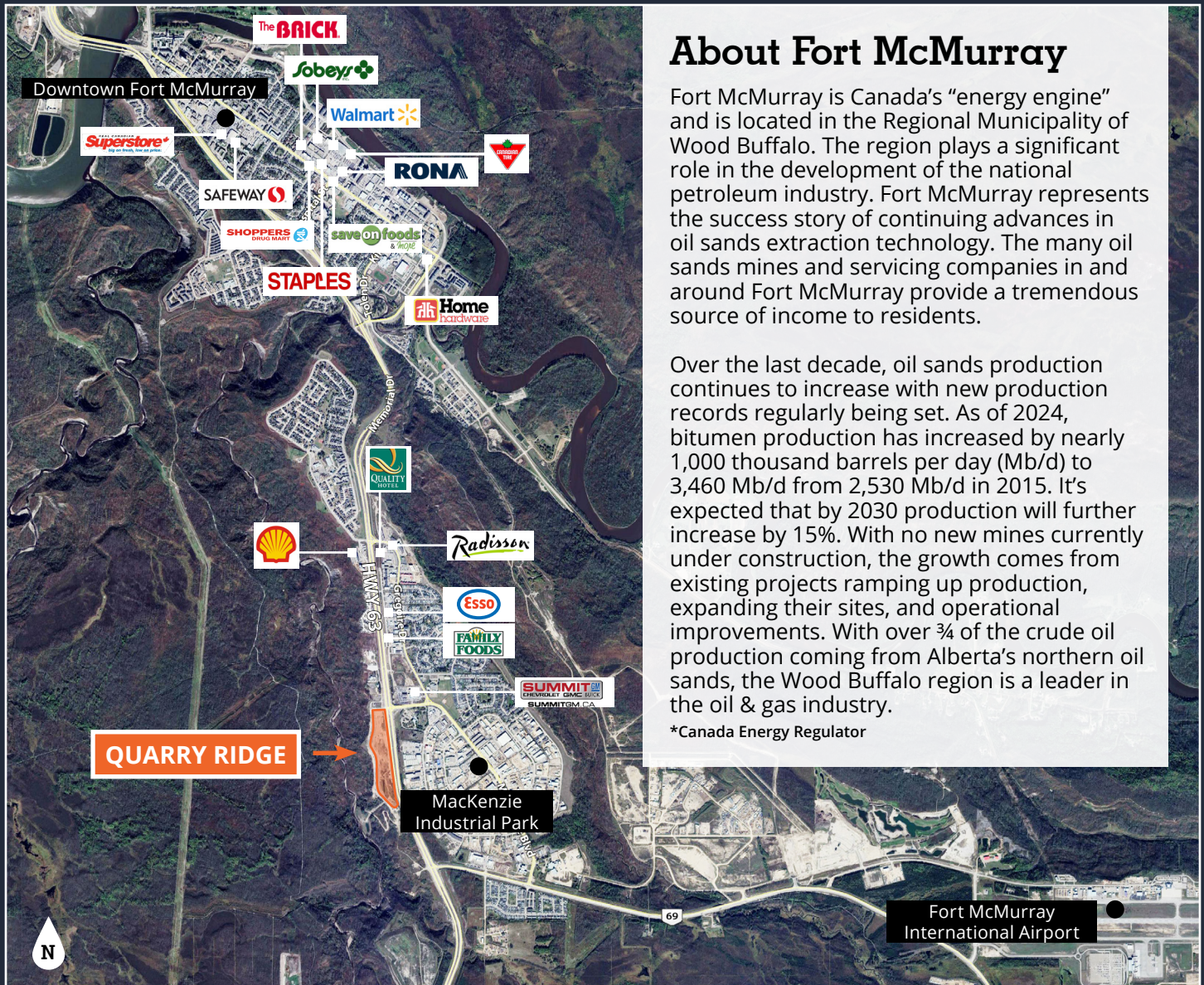

## About Fort McMurray

Fort McMurray is Canada's "energy engine" and is located in the Regional Municipality of Wood Buffalo. The region plays a significant role in the development of the national petroleum industry. Fort McMurray represents the success story of continuing advances in oil sands extraction technology. The many oil sands mines and servicing companies in and around Fort McMurray provide a tremendous source of income to residents.

Over the last decade, oil sands production continues to increase with new production records regularly being set. As of 2024, bitumen production has increased by nearly 1,000 thousand barrels per day (Mb/d) to 3,460 Mb/d from 2,530 Mb/d in 2015. It's expected that by 2030 production will further increase by 15%. With no new mines currently under construction, the growth comes from existing projects ramping up production, expanding their sites, and operational improvements. With over  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the crude oil production coming from Alberta's northern oil sands, the Wood Buffalo region is a leader in the oil & gas industry.
