

THE WORLD IN A NEIGHBORHOOD

At the turn of the 20th century, Ybor City's streets were a collision of cultures and people. The smell of freshly baked Cuban bread filled the streets in the morning; Italian, Jewish and Cuban social clubs popped up along the main avenue; and the sounds of zarzuelas and flamenco music drifted out of bars at night. In 1905, patrons may have popped into the Columbia Restaurant for a quick drink....just as they do today, more than 115 years since they opened their doors.

Historic Ybor remains a multicultural culinary, nightlife, and hospitality hotbed for the city of Tampa and its 27 million annual visitors.
