



One Hanson Place is one of the city's archi-tectural icons and an officially designated NYC landmark. Originally constructed as The Williamsburgh Savings Bank Tower in 1929, the building was converted in 2007 into luxury condominiums, residential on the upper floors of the tower and office condos on the lower floors and the cathedral-like bank atrium dedicated to hosting special events.

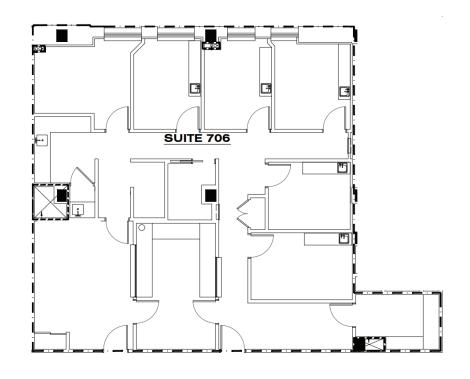
