The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 70.0 in the identified area, compared to 63.5 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$46,214 in the area, compared to \$54,149 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$51,538 in five years, compared to \$59,476 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$57,970 in this area, compared to \$77,008 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$63,312 in five years, compared to \$84,021 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$21,578 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$29,472. The per capita income is projected to be \$23,605 in five years, compared to \$32,025 for all U.S. households

Currently, 54.8% of the 21,271 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 34.9%, renter occupied; and 10.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.9% are renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 19,001 housing units in the area - 59.0% owner occupied, 33.4% renter occupied, and 7.6% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 5.14%. Median home value in the area is \$130,671, compared to a median home value of \$198,891 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.78% annually to \$157,305.
