**SANFORD APPROVES 140-ACRE INDUSTRIAL PARK
AS AREA BOOMS · DECEMBER 2023**

Sanket Dalal, founder and CEO of Cary-based investment company Anvaya Investments, is planning to launch and operate a 100-room WoodSpring Suites hotel off N.C. Highway 87 South. He told Triangle Business Journal he hopes to open the hotel in late 2024 and said it will employ 12 to 15 people."

**RED-HOT SANFORD USING \$4.4M TO CREATE
DOWNTOWN MARKETPLACE · NOVEMBER 2023**

"A growing city in the Greater Triangle region is working to build an "agricultural marketplace" to bolster its downtown, support local farmers and address food insecurity.

The City of Sanford, through designer HH Architecture, has submitted initial plans for the structure, which will consist of more than 12,000 square feet including more than 8,000 square feet for an open-air market. The project is a collaboration between several entities, including the City of Sanford, Lee County and the Lee County Cooperative Extension, part of the NC Cooperative Extension, and will be located at 157 Charlotte Avenue downtown...

Along with being a staple farmer's market for the Sandhills region, providing reliable, healthy food for residents in the downtown area who lack a grocery store nearby is a priority for the project. According to Stone, the space will have a demonstration kitchen for classes on shopping for and cooking healthy meals on a budget. Additionally, there will be meeting space, office space, a shared kitchen for food entrepreneurs and more."
