


Blanket Mills

The historic Northern Ohio Blanket Mills building is 112,000 SF on 2.2-acres, and recently underwent a \$35M mix-use renovation in Cleveland's Clark-Fulton neighborhood. The original 19th-century factory was once the country's largest manufacturer of woolen horse blankets and carriage robes.

- Constructed in 1896 and is listed on the Federal Registry of Historic Places
- 7,300 SF of loft style, brick-and-beam, high-ceiling office or retail available
- Free parking in adjacent surface lots controlled by landlord
- Excellent highway proximity
- Adjacent to St. Rocco's Church; new Metro Health campus;
 Johnny's on Fulton; Tremont & Ohio City
- Ample Tenant Improvement Allowance (TIA) or Turn-Key opportunities
- Dedicated entranceways from parking lots
- Ground floor building signage opportunities
