Executive Summary

The Boulder Group is pleased to exclusively market for sale a single tenant zero cash flow CVS property located in Rosenberg, Texas within the Houston MSA. CVS has successfully operated from this location following the completion of construction in 2016. CVS is operating on a long-term lease that runs through January 2042. The lease is absolute triple net and presents no landlord responsibilities. There are ten 5-year renewal options with various rental escalations. Additionally, the property benefits from its location in Texas, as an income tax free state

The 14,000 square-foot building is located at a signalized intersection along Reading Road, which carries 21,000 vehicles per day. The site also benefits from close proximity to Interstate 69 (69,000 VPD) providing strong regional access. The property is positioned directly across from Brazos Town Center, a dominant regional shopping destination anchored by Target, The Home Depot, Kroger, Kohl's, Academy Sports, Hobby Lobby, Ross, and numerous additional national retailers. Other nearby tenants include H-E-B, ALDI, Cinemark, Goodwill, and Honda. The site is also located just two miles southeast of B.F. Terry High School, which enrolls approximately 1,500 students. The surrounding trade area continues to experience strong growth, with the population within one mile projected to increase by 23% through 2029. As of 2026, the five-mile radius includes approximately 133,000 residents with an average household income exceeding \$114,000.

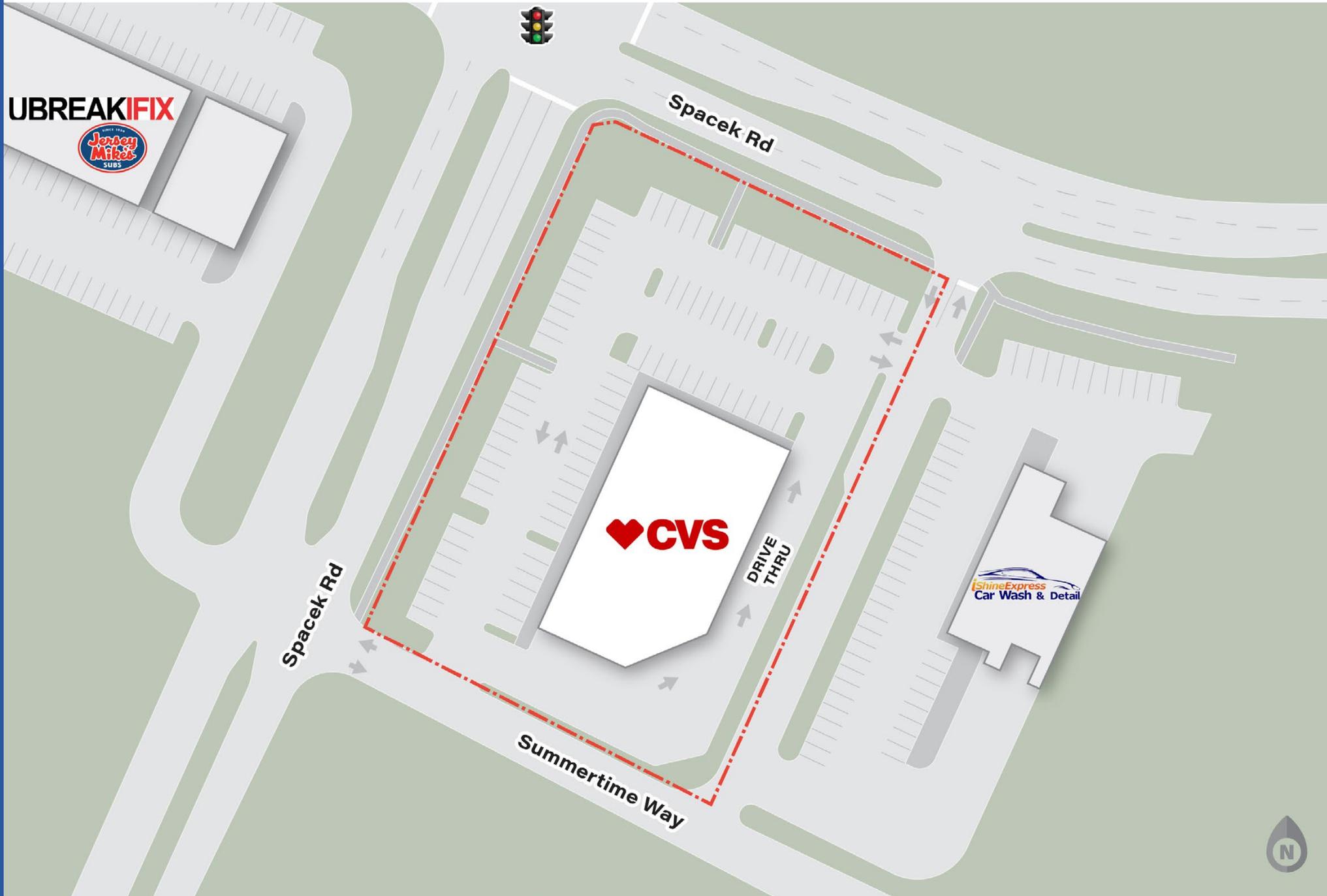

Location Overview

ROSENBERG, TEXAS

Rosenberg, Texas, is a rapidly growing city in Fort Bend County, located within the Houston–The Woodlands–Sugar Land metropolitan area, approximately 28 miles southwest of downtown Houston. Situated on the south side of the Brazos River and adjacent to the county seat of Richmond, the city was named after Henry Von Rosenberg, a Swiss immigrant who arrived in Texas in 1843 and later became a key figure in regional settlement and as president of the Gulf, Colorado and Santa Fe Railway. Founded in the 1880s as a railroad junction town following the refusal of nearby Richmond to grant right-of-way to rail lines, Rosenberg has experienced significant population growth, rising from 30,618 residents in the 2010 census to 38,282 in 2020, with recent estimates projecting around 42,000–44,000 by 2026 amid ongoing suburban expansion. The community hosts the annual Fort Bend County Fair in October and features modern attractions like the Fort Bend Epicenter arena, while benefiting from its strategic position along major highways such as I-69/US-59 for easy access to Houston and beyond.

MSA Overview

HOUSTON, TEXAS MSA

The Houston–The Woodlands–Sugar Land metropolitan statistical area (MSA), commonly known as Greater Houston, is the fifth-most populous MSA in the United States, encompassing ten counties in Southeast Texas along the Gulf Coast: Austin, Brazoria, Chambers, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Liberty, Montgomery, San Jacinto, and Waller. Centered on the city of Houston—the nation’s fourth-largest city and a global hub for energy, trade, and biomedical research—the region spans approximately 10,000 square miles (slightly smaller than Massachusetts) and boasts a population of about 7.82 million as of 2025 estimates, with rapid growth adding nearly 200,000 residents in 2024 alone due to domestic migration, international immigration, and economic opportunities. The area’s economy, with a gross metropolitan product exceeding \$600 billion (ranking seventh nationally), is anchored by the Port of Houston (the busiest in the U.S. for foreign trade), the world’s largest concentration of petrochemical facilities, 24 Fortune 500 headquarters, and major sectors including energy, aerospace, healthcare (home to the renowned Texas Medical Center), and manufacturing. Known for its exceptional ethnic and cultural diversity—often ranked among the most diverse major metros—the Houston MSA features a vibrant mix of communities, world-class institutions like Rice University and the University of Houston, extensive freeway networks, and resilience in the face of challenges like hurricanes and flooding, continuing its trajectory as one of the fastest-growing and most dynamic urban regions in the country.

Information About Brokerage Services

Texas law requires all real estate license holders to give the following information about brokerage services to prospective buyers, tenants, sellers and landlords.



TYPES OF REAL ESTATE LICENSE HOLDERS:

- **A BROKER** is responsible for all brokerage activities, including acts performed by sales agents sponsored by the broker.
- **A SALES AGENT** must be sponsored by a broker and works with clients on behalf of the broker.

A BROKER'S MINIMUM DUTIES REQUIRED BY LAW (A client is the person or party that the broker represents):

- Put the interests of the client above all others, including the broker's own interests;
- Inform the client of any material information about the property or transaction received by the broker;
- Answer the client's questions and present any offer to or counter-offer from the client; and
- Treat all parties to a real estate transaction honestly and fairly.

A LICENSE HOLDER CAN REPRESENT A PARTY IN A REAL ESTATE TRANSACTION:

AS AGENT FOR OWNER (SELLER/LANDLORD): The broker becomes the property owner's agent through an agreement with the owner, usually in a written listing to sell or property management agreement. An owner's agent must perform the broker's minimum duties above and must inform the owner of any material information about the property or transaction known by the agent, including information disclosed to the agent or subagent by the buyer or buyer's agent.

AS AGENT FOR BUYER/TENANT: The broker becomes the buyer/tenant's agent by agreeing to represent the buyer, usually through a written representation agreement. A buyer's agent must perform the broker's minimum duties above and must inform the buyer of any material information about the property or transaction known by the agent, including information disclosed to the agent by the seller or seller's agent.

AS AGENT FOR BOTH - INTERMEDIARY: To act as an intermediary between the parties the broker must first obtain the written agreement of *each party* to the transaction. The written agreement must state who will pay the broker and, in conspicuous bold or underlined print, set forth the broker's obligations as an intermediary. A broker who acts as an intermediary:

- Must treat all parties to the transaction impartially and fairly;
- May, with the parties' written consent, appoint a different license holder associated with the broker to each party (owner and buyer) to communicate with, provide opinions and advice to, and carry out the instructions of each party to the transaction.
- Must not, unless specifically authorized in writing to do so by the party, disclose:
 - that the owner will accept a price less than the written asking price;
 - that the buyer/tenant will pay a price greater than the price submitted in a written offer; and
 - any confidential information or any other information that a party specifically instructs the broker in writing not to disclose, unless required to do so by law.

AS SUBAGENT: A license holder acts as a subagent when aiding a buyer in a transaction without an agreement to represent the buyer. A subagent can assist the buyer but does not represent the buyer and must place the interests of the owner first.

TO AVOID DISPUTES, ALL AGREEMENTS BETWEEN YOU AND A BROKER SHOULD BE IN WRITING AND CLEARLY ESTABLISH:

- The broker's duties and responsibilities to you, and your obligations under the representation agreement.
- Who will pay the broker for services provided to you, when payment will be made and how the payment will be calculated.
