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





SUMBARKET

Johnston County is strategically located at the junction of North Carolina Interstates 95 and 40, making the county the North-South and East-West connection of the state. Ideally situated only 30 minutes east of Raleigh, NC and the Triangle region's esteemed Research Triangle Park, Johnston County continues to attract diverse industries and opportunities for companies and residents alike. The region has emerged as a key destination for bio-manufacturing jobs and investments. The County is home to eleven municipalities including Benson, Clayton, Four Oaks, Kenly, Selma and Smithfield. Smithfield is mid-way along I-95 and is the 0-mile marker between New York City and Jacksonville, Florida.

Travel throughout North Carolina rose 15.2 percent in 2022 to set a record \$33.3 billion in visitor spending - \$284.9 million of which was in Johnston County alone. Johnston County saw an 11.5% increase in visitor spending from 2021 and is ranked third in the Triangle region behind Wake and Durham counties.

ECONOMY / DEMOGRAPHICS

Johnston County continues to demonstrate healthy economic growth and strong demographics. The county's unemployment rate stood at 3% as of September 2023.

Johnston County is now the fastest growing county in the state of North Carolina. The county's population of 277,924 has expanded by 36.27% since 2010 and is projected to expand by another 2.09% annually over the next few years.

Smithfield, nestled between the Neuse River and Interstate 95, is bustling with thriving, independently-owned business. It is a destination for art, history, shopping, dining, and more. Over the past year, 140 townhome units were recently completed in Smithfield with over 1,100 single and multifamily units approved for development.

EDUCATION


Located in Smithfield, Johnston Community College is an awardwinning two-year school. The community college offers several associate degree programs and specialty training for many industries while serving more than 15,000 students with an annual budget of \$400 million.

Within 50 miles of Johnston County, residents have access to both private colleges and internationally recognized, researchdriven universities. Campbell University, Barton College, Shaw University, Meredith College, and North Carolina Wesleyan College are private colleges that are near Johnston County and contribute significantly to the Triangle's exceptional workforce. Major universities in the Research Triangle Park area such as Duke University, UNC-Chapel Hill and North Carolina State University provide an exceptional talent pipeline and intellectual capital for the region's growing businesses. In 2020, 24% of Johnston County residents held a bachelor's, graduate or professional degree.

EMPLOYMENT


Johnston County's favorable business climate and access to the region's highly educated workforce continue to attract major corporations, driving innovation and economic opportunity. New and expanding businesses are creating thousands of jobs in Johnston County, resulting in a vibrant community and strong tax base. While the county benefits from a diverse industry base, 22% of Johnston County's workforce is employed in manufacturing. Major manufacturing operations include companies such as Novo Nordisk, Grifols and Caterpillar. Other major employers include Johnston County Schools and Johnston Health.
