To

Marin Municipal Water Dist.

This Indenture made and entered into this 18th day of October, 1916,  
by and between Cascade Land Co., a Corporation, party of the first part, and Marin Municipal  
Water District, a Public Corporation, the party of the second part; Witnesseth: That for and  
in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand, six hundred and twenty seven and 50/100 (\$2,627.50)  
Dollars, Gold coin of the United States to it in hand paid by the party of the second part, the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first part does hereby grant, barter  
and sell unto the party of the second part, a right of way over, and along, through and across  
the route hereinafter described, to lay, maintain, repair, remove and replace four conduit lines  
constructed of concrete, wood, iron, steel or any other suitable or appropriate material or  
materials of an inside diameter of thirty six inches each and capable of carrying fifty  
million gallons of water per day, the same to be buried in the ground except where they cross  
depressions, ravines and gulches, where the same will be placed upon concrete trestles raised  
above the surface thereof, together with all necessary or proper valves, branches, hydrants and  
all stations or meters necessary or proper for the controlling of the flow of the water in  
said conduit lines or pipes hereinabove mentioned, and also a right of way over and along  
said route hereinabove described for a wagon road twenty feet wide and for the erection of all  
necessary bridges and culverts used in connection therewith, for the purpose of allowing the  
free passage thereon of all wagons, teams, horses, motor trucks, traction engines or other  
suitable or proper devices or machinery for the transportation of material and supplies for the  
construction of said conduit lines and other property, and constructing herein mentioned, and for  
the construction of all tunnels, dams and all other work necessary or proper for the carrying out  
and maintenance of the general system adopted by the Board of Directors of the Marin Municipal  
Water District for the construction and operation and maintenance of its water works system  
and also a right of way for a pole line composed of round or sawed poles, together with the  
necessary guy wires, lines and anchors for the stringing of wires for telephone or telegraph line  
and heat, light and power lines for use in connection with and as a part of the water works system  
of the party of the second part, together with the right and liberty of cutting and clearing from  
said right of way all trees and brush now growing on, or that may hereafter grow upon or  
extend over the same from trees growing without said right of way, and also the privilege of  
patrolling the said right of way, and erecting suitable gates in any and all fences that  
may be constructed across the same, by Cascade Land Co., or its assigns. The said right of way  
shall be subject to the right of the Cascade Land Co., its successors or assigns, the use the  
road constructed upon said right of way as a highway and to construct and maintain roads leading  
to and across the said right of way, and to enter upon said right of way and construct and  
maintain therein and thereon gas, water and sewer pipes either alone or upon the same, and to  
construct and maintain conduits and pole lines and string wires for telephone and telegraph  
lines and heat, light and power lines, and to improve said road along said right of way and to  
beautify the said right of way by planting flowers, shrubs and trees thereon, providing that  
none of said acts and reservations so made to the party of the first part herein shall  
in any way interfere with the construction, operation or maintenance of the waterworks  
system about to be constructed by the party of the second part, and at any time in the future  
when said party of the second part may desire to install additional pipe lines or conduits or  
any of the machinery or apparatus incident thereto, or pole lines as by this right of way mentioned  
the same may be installed by the party of the second part without hindrance in the part

of the Cascade Land Co. or its successors, and the improvements so placed on said right of way by the party of the second part shall have paramount right over those installed by Cascade Land Co., its successors or assigns, and in case of interference between the improvements of Cascade Land Co already installed and those of the party of the second part to be installed, the party of the second part shall have the right to install its said improvements, for which it has hereby been granted a right of way, without further compensation to Cascade Land Co., its successors and assigns. Said right of way is located upon all that certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the Rancho Canada de Herrera, in the County of Marin, State of California and more particularly described as follows, to wit;

A strip of land 100 feet wide and 4475.17 feet long, lying and being 50 feet on each side of a surveyed line marked on the ground by a line of surveyor's stakes and being all of the land for fifty feet on each side of said surveyed line which lies within the exterior boundaries of said Rancho Canada de Herrera. The center line of said right of way is described as follows, to wit;

Beginning at a stake marked A.L. 4+49.83 F.O.C. which bears North 14° 00' West 1037.66 feet from post P.Q. 109 & Hill, said post being the common corner of the Rancho Tomales y Baulines, the Rancho Punta de Quintin and the Rancho Canada De Herrera, said point of beginning being located as above and said post P.Q. 109& Hill being the most southwesterly corner of the Rancho Canada De Herrera; running thence in a generally Easterly direction along a surveyed line more particularly described in the field notes as follows to wit;

At approximately stake Al 49+25.00 P.O.C. on the Southerly boundary line of the Rancho Canada De Herrera, which said stake bears North 83° 15' East 3011.76 feet from post P.Q. 109 & H1 hereinbefore mentioned, the said center line crosses the boundary line of the Rancho Punta De Quentin. The total area of said strip of land lying within the boundaries of the Rancho Canada De Herrera is 10.49 acres. As a further consideration for the conveyance of the above described right of way, the party of the second part does hereby agree to install and maintain at each of the following points along the hereinabove mentioned right of way, to wit; at Station 6+83.97; at Station 20+06.24; at Station 34+36.81 and at Station 47+13.56, a connection from the conduit lines here after to be installed by the party of the second part on said right of way, from which service mains can be connected so as to place the lands of Cascade Land Co lying below said right of way under water service by gravity. In witness whereof, the party of the first part has caused these presents to be duly executed and its corporate seal to be attached the day and year first above written.
