The Electric Works campus first became a center of industrial innovation in 1883. At its peak in 1944, the height of WWII, GE employed about a third of Fort Wayne's workforce. For more than eight decades, the campus churned out electric motors, electrical transformers, and more electronic wonders.

In 2015, GE finally closed the campus to stay competitive in a rapidly changing marketplace. 39 acres, eighteen historic buildings, and more than 1.2 million square feet of space in the heart of Fort Wayne sat vacant, waiting for the chance to be reborn and to generate new experiences and new ideas. In 2017, RTM Ventures acquired the property and crafted a plan with the community for a mixed-use development that would become Electric Works.
