Executive Summary

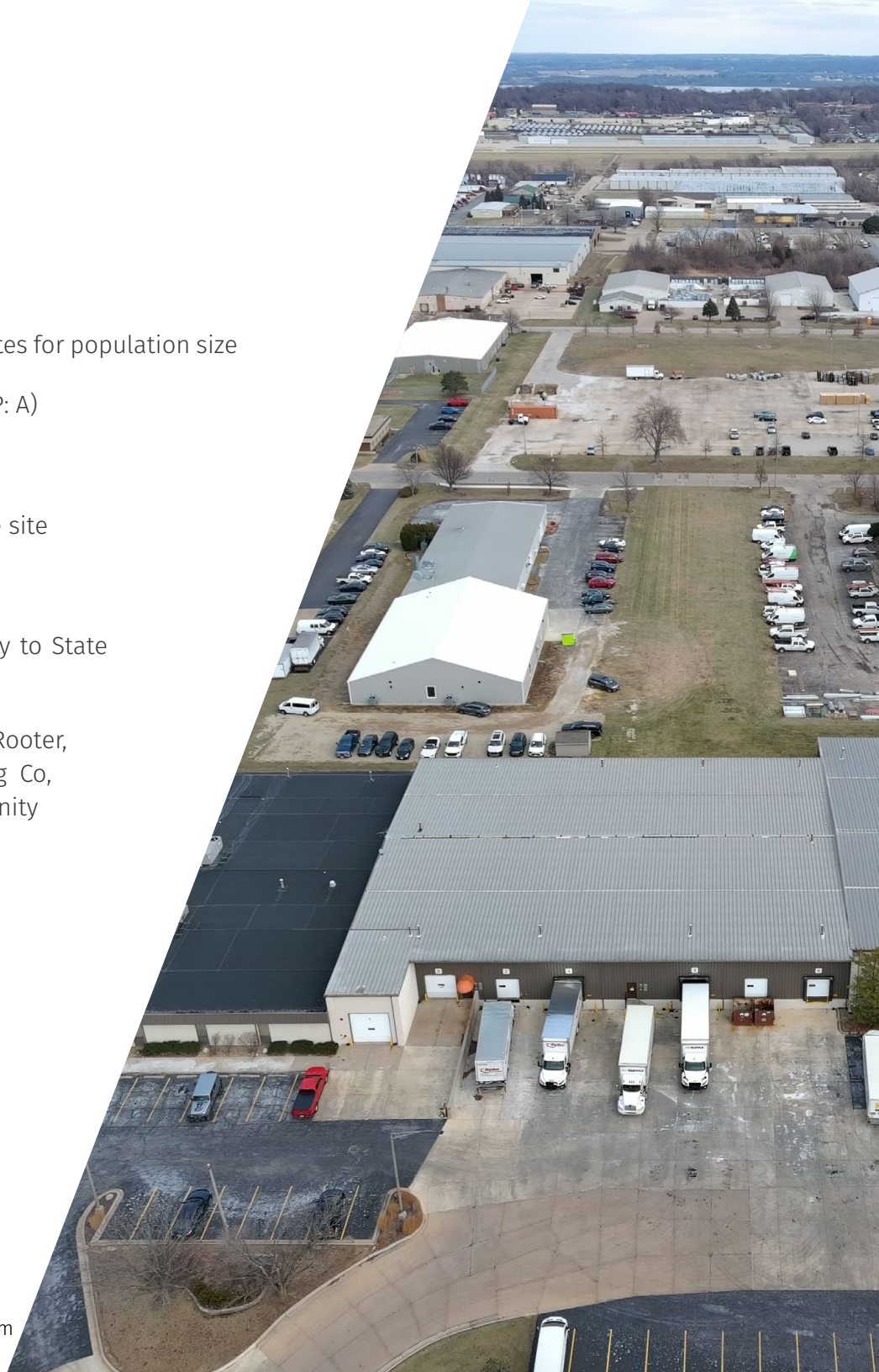
The Boulder Group, in association with Joseph & Camper, is pleased to exclusively market for sale a single tenant net leased HD Supply (Subsidiary of The Home Depot) property located in Peoria, Illinois. HD Supply has successfully operated at this location since 1999 and has executed multiple lease extensions, most recently in 2025, demonstrating commitment to the site. The property sits on a large 3-acre parcel. As an added benefit to potential buyers, the lease contains no remaining renewal options, with the tenant currently paying low rent of \$7.36 per square foot. Market vacancy in the area is below 5%, according to CoStar, and the asset is being offered at an attractive price of \$67 per square foot.

The 69,758-square-foot building benefits from a strategic location just off North Allen Road and State Route 6, which carry approximately 20,600 and 24,900 vehicles per day, respectively. The property is situated within a dense industrial corridor anchored by established tenants including Roto-Rooter, Advanced Technology Services, Trigo-SCSI, Brewers Distributing Co., Peoria Production Solutions, U-Haul, Ryder Truck Rental, Community Wholesale Tire, Keling Roofing Company, and others. Additionally, several nearby retailers, including Walmart Supercenter, Menards, ALDI, and multiple automotive dealerships (Ford, Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep, and RAM), drive strong daytime traffic to the area. Approximately 171,000 people reside within a 10-mile radius of the property, with households within a 3-mile radius earning an average household income exceeding \$135,000.

HD Supply is a leading wholesale distributor of maintenance, repair, and operations (MRO) products in North America, specializing in supplies for multifamily, hospitality, healthcare, institutional, commercial, government, and education facilities. Originally founded in 1974 as Maintenance Warehouse and acquired by The Home Depot in 1997, the company evolved through various acquisitions and ownership changes—including a period as a publicly traded entity after its 2013 IPO—before being reacquired by The Home Depot in December 2020 for approximately \$8 billion (following the earlier spin-off of its White Cap construction unit). As a wholly owned subsidiary of The Home Depot, HD Supply operates an extensive network of over 100 distribution centers across the U.S. and Canada, serving more than 250,000 professional customers.

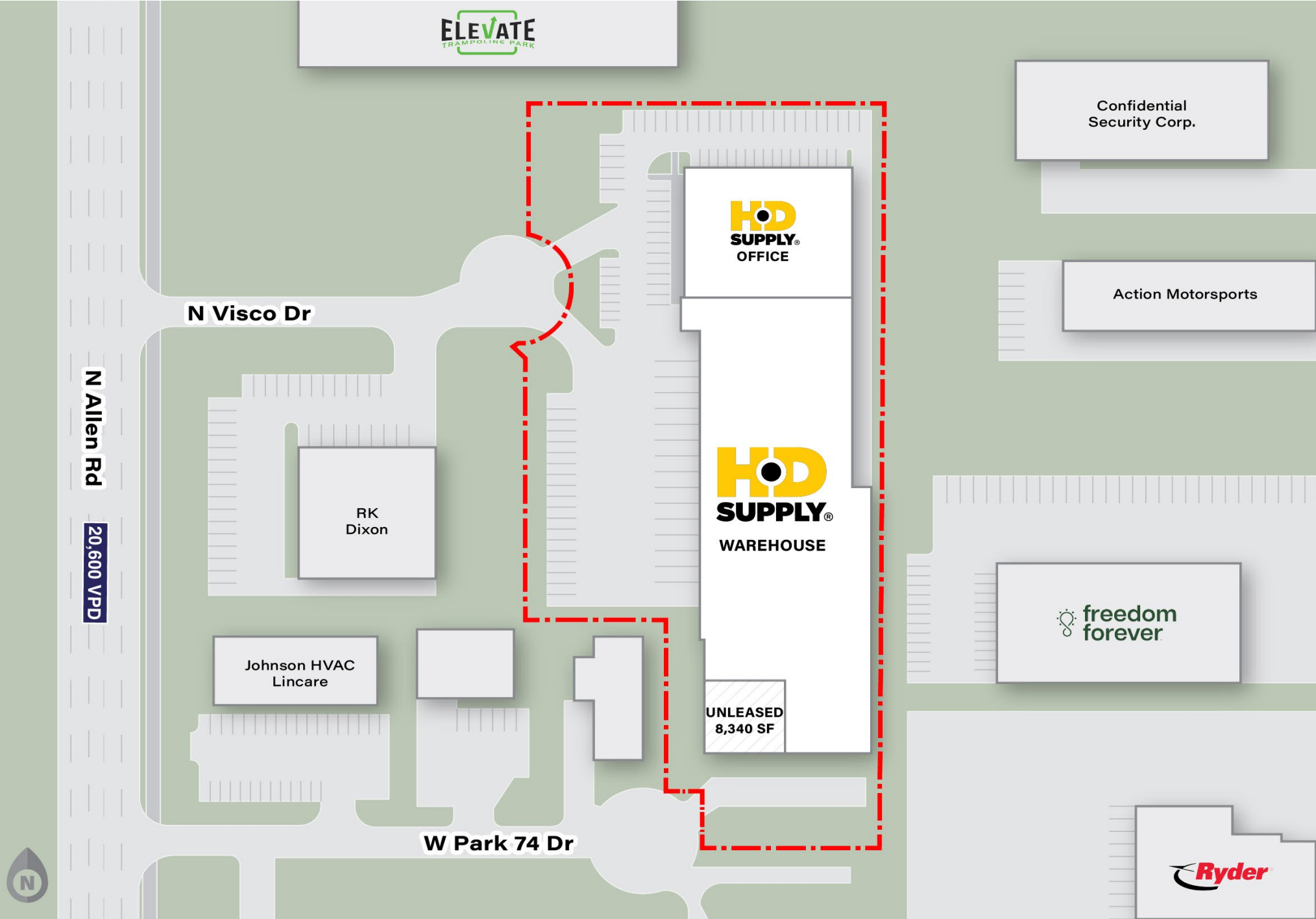

Location Overview

PEORIA, ILLINOIS

Peoria, Illinois, is one of the oldest permanent European settlements in the state, with roots tracing back to 1680 when French explorer René-Robert Cavelier, Sieur de La Salle, built Fort Crèvecoeur nearby along the Illinois River. The area was later fortified by the French in 1691, and the modern city—named after the Peoria tribe of the Illinois Confederation—was incorporated in 1845. Situated on the Illinois River, Peoria grew into a major industrial hub during the 19th and 20th centuries, becoming a key center for whiskey production before Prohibition and later earning fame as a testing ground for mainstream appeal with the phrase “Will it play in Peoria?” Historically significant events include Abraham Lincoln’s 1854 speech against the Kansas-Nebraska Act delivered in the city. Today, as of recent estimates around 2025, Peoria has a population of approximately 111,700 to 113,000, making it the eighth-largest city in Illinois and the principal city of its metropolitan area.

The city’s economy remains diversified, with a strong emphasis on manufacturing, healthcare, and agriculture-related trade, as Peoria serves as a major port on the Illinois River for shipping corn, soybeans, and livestock. Although Caterpillar Inc. relocated its global headquarters away from Peoria in the late 2010s, the company continues to be a significant employer in the region with thousands of local jobs in manufacturing earthmoving equipment and related products. Healthcare now dominates as the largest sector, led by OSF HealthCare (the top employer) and other providers like Carle Health. Notable landmarks include the Peoria Riverfront Museum, the Peoria Zoo, historic sites like the Hotel Père Marquette, and scenic Grandview Drive overlooking the river. The city also boasts cultural institutions such as Bradley University, the Peoria Symphony Orchestra, and annual events like the Heart of Illinois Fair and the oldest Santa Claus Parade in the U.S.
