



LOCATION DESCRIPTION

Mobile is the county seat of Mobile County, Alabama. It is the fourth most-populated city in Alabama, after Huntsville, Birmingham, and Montgomery. Being Alabama's only saltwater port, Mobile is located on the Mobile River at the head of Mobile Bay on the north-central Gulf Coast. The Port of Mobile has always played a key role in the economic health of the city, beginning with the settlement as an important trading center between the French colonists and Native Americans, down to its current role as the 12th-largest port in the United States. Mobile is the principal municipality of the Mobile metropolitan area. This region of 430,197 residents is composed of Mobile and Washington counties; it is the third-largest metropolitan statistical area in the state. Mobile is also the largest city in the Mobile-Daphne-Fairhope area, with a total population of 661,964, the second largest such area in the state. Doing business in Mobile has never been easier. The City of Mobile and the Mobile Area Chamber of Commerce work together to provide a prosperous environment for all of the local businesses.
