

OVERVIEW

Situated in Charlotte's Optimist Park neighborhood, Oxbow totals six floors with over 11,700 square feet of commercial space fronting N Davidson Street at the intersection with East 25th Street. A total of 389 rental units range from studio apartments to four-bedroom units. The street-level retail is ideal for restaurants, coffee shops and other neighborhood services. Amenities include a gym, rooftop patio, bike storage and a resident courtyard.

- 389 unit mid-rise multifamily development with over 11,700 SF of ground-floor retail
- Offering a mix of micro and traditional retail spaces ranging from 791 - 2,952 SF
- Located about a block from the 25th Street blue line light rail station
- Surrounded by over 5,000 apartments units and townhomes
- Adjacent to the Cross Charlotte Trail, a 30+-mile trail that will stretch from Pineville through Center City and on to the UNC Charlotte campus and Cabarrus County line

Oxbow offers one of Charlotte's most walkable and connected locations, ideal for both residents and business owners. Just a block away from the LYNX Blue Line and directly connected to the Charlotte Cross Trail, it gives people easy access to explore the city by foot or bike.






THE LIGHT RAIL: CONNECTED



THE OPTIMIST PARK/ **NODA NEIGHBORHOOD**






Existing multifamily

Greenway/Cross Charlotte Trail


