STUDIO UNITS

74 independent living studio units total. 66 units are two bedroom, one Jack & Jill bathroom. Other units are one bedroom, one bathroom.

BUILDING MECHANICS

All mechanics and roof were replaced as part of a major renovation done in 2019 to adapt the property from a skilled nursing facility to an independent senior housing facility. The building has two working elevators.

PACE LOAN

Owner used PACE financing to improve efficiency in the building in 2021. Loan is approximately \$90,000 per year and will be assumed by buyer.







Olde Town East

New Developments in Olde Towne East

18th & Oak Mixed-Use Development

A new five-story mixeduse development featuring 117 apartments over 4,600 SF of ground-floor retail.

Broad Street Arts and Senior Campus

A new facility, called the Broad Street Arts and Senior Campus, will provide space for a variety of Columbus Recreation and Parks Department programming.

Parsons & Capital Mixed-Use Development

A new six-story, 51-unit mixed-use development with approximately 3,000 SF of ground floor commercial space.

The Columbus Street Rail Project

A mixed-use project, rehabilitating five buildings totaling more than 60,000 SF at the northeast corner of Oak Street and Kelton Avenue. The project is seen as a multitenant space that will include multiple office and retail tenants.
