Currently, 52.9% of the 63,830 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 34.3%, renter occupied; and 12.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 59,750 housing units in the area - 56.7% owner occupied, 30.2% renter occupied, and 13.1% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.98%. Median home value in the area is \$149,784, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 5.01% annually to \$191,217.
