SURVEYOR'S NOTE

The Theoretical Uncertainty (due to random errors in measurement) of the corners of the subject tract established this survey is within the specifications for a Class C Survey (± 0.5 feet).

That line was established on this survey from existing monuments on that line. The iron pipe found at the southwest corner of the subject tract was recognized as a requarter section line point.
