

Currently, 72.3% of the 24,190 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 14.9% renter occupied; and 12.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 17,984 housing units in the area - 68.8% owner occupied, 16.1% renter occupied, and 15.2% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 14.08%.
