


Currently, 78.3% of the 7,218 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 16.5%, renter occupied; and 5.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. 








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
