Summary

The southern portion of the building also has an enclosed loading dock area not included in the actual marketed square footage. 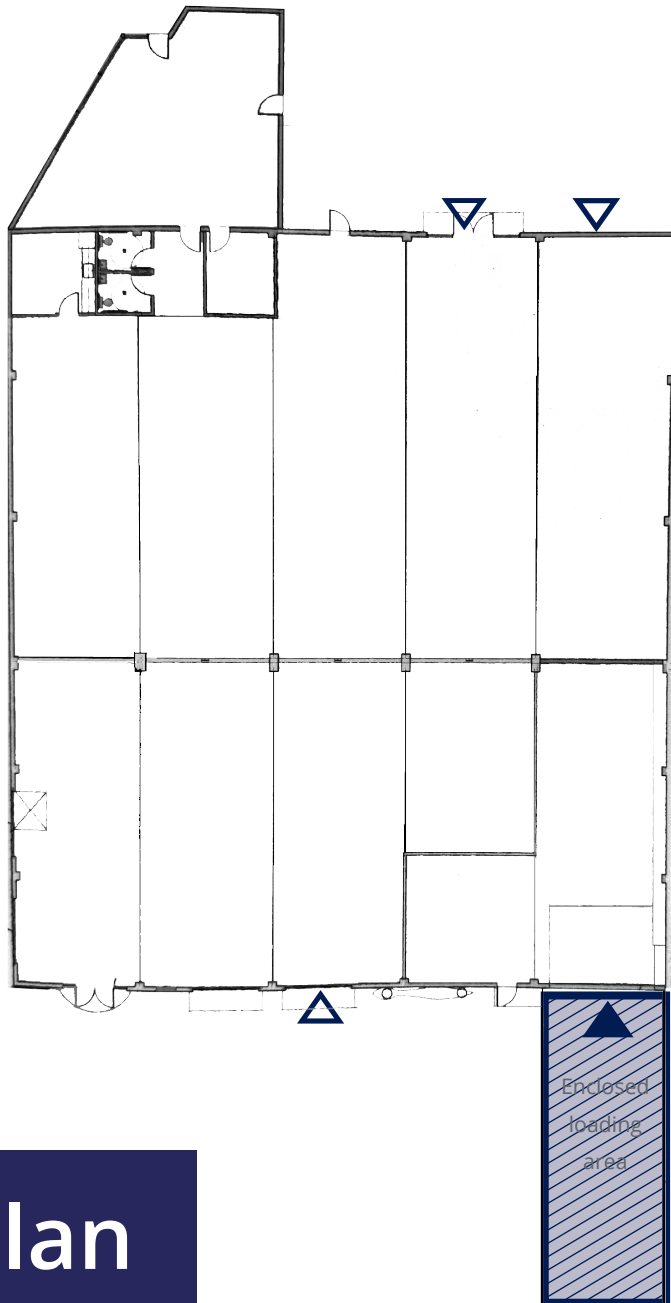

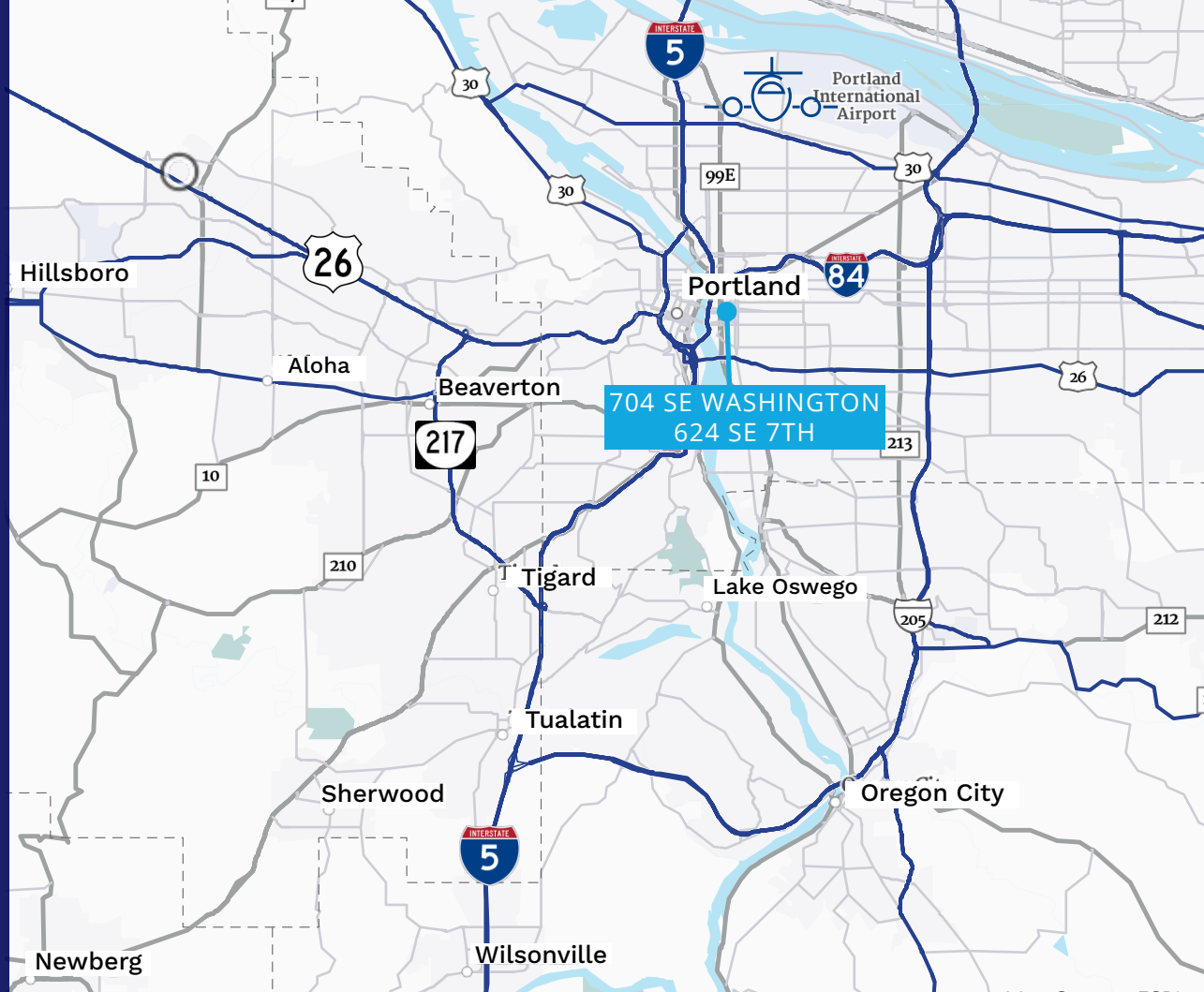

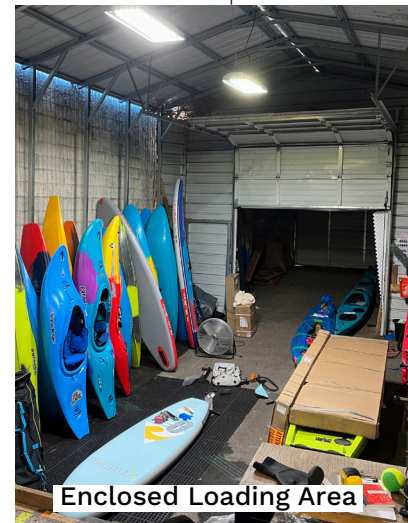
