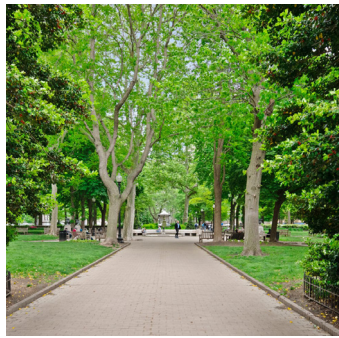
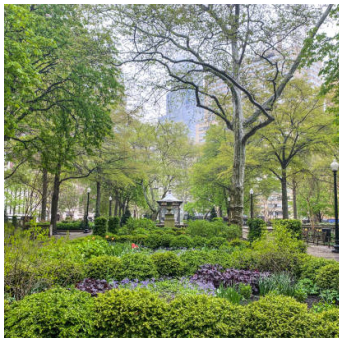

THE HISTORY

Constructed in 1890 during Philadelphia's late-19th-century expansion westward from the historic core, 1631 Locust Street is part of the architecturally significant 1600 block of Locust Street bordering Rittenhouse Square.

The building, designed along with its twin at 1633 Locust, was crafted in the Georgian Revival style by prominent architects Walter Cope and John Stewardson, known for their influential work at academic institutions and in elite Philadelphia neighborhoods. The pair's designs helped define the sophisticated architectural character of the area around Rittenhouse Square in the late 1800s and early 1900s.

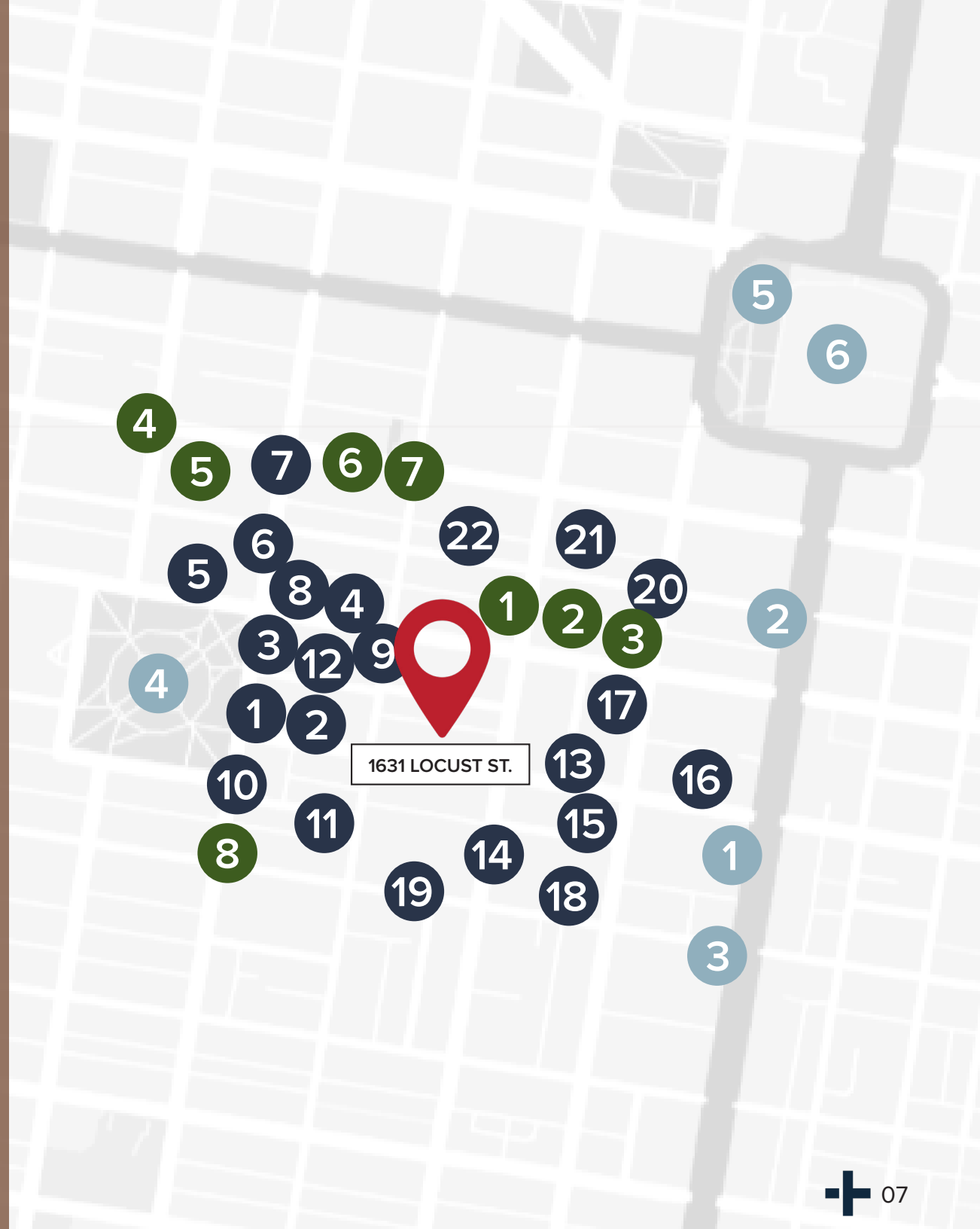
