





Currently, 41.1% of the 83,587 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 38.7%, renter occupied; and 20.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 81,495 housing units in the area - 45.5% owner occupied, 37.7% renter occupied, and 16.8% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.13%. Median home value in the area is \$95,207, compared to a median home value of \$264,021 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 8.26% annually to \$141,580.
