

PROPERTY LOCATION

Accessible to both Los Angeles and Ventura Counties via the 23 and 101 Freeways, the shopping center is well positioned in northern Thousand Oaks near major community institutions, and away from other supermarket/drug anchored centers.

- Cal Lutheran, a private university of over 3,500 students plus faculty and staff, is just a half mile away. It is also home to the Los Angeles Rams football team (in-season training facility).
- Several large senior-living communities are situated within a mile, including University Village, The Reserve at Thousand Oaks, and Belmont Village Senior Living.
- Nearby schools include Thousand Oaks High School, La Reina High School (private), Conejo Valley Adult School and others.

- No competing neighborhood centers are located within a mile.
