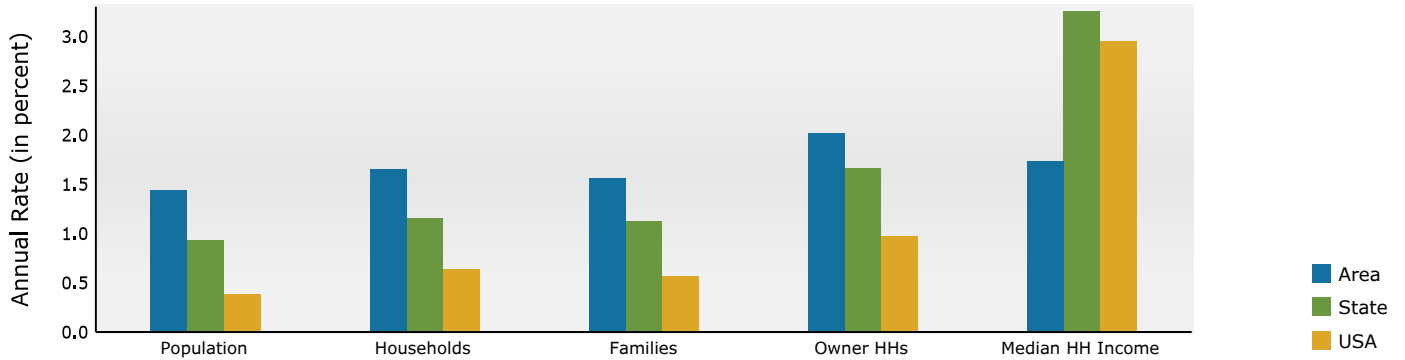

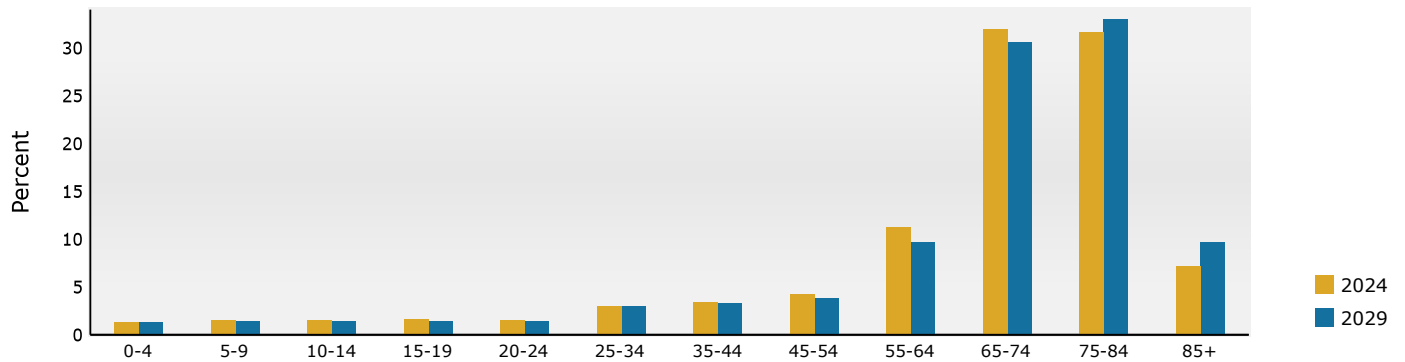

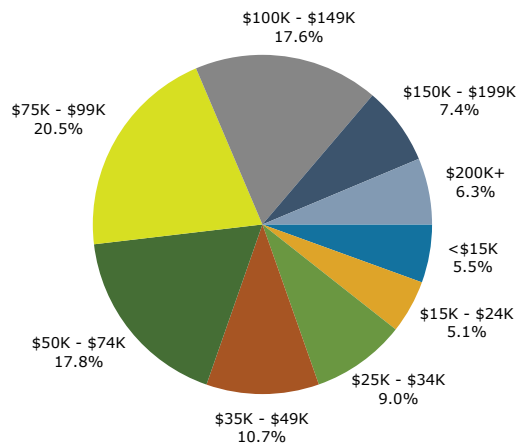
## Trends 2024-2029



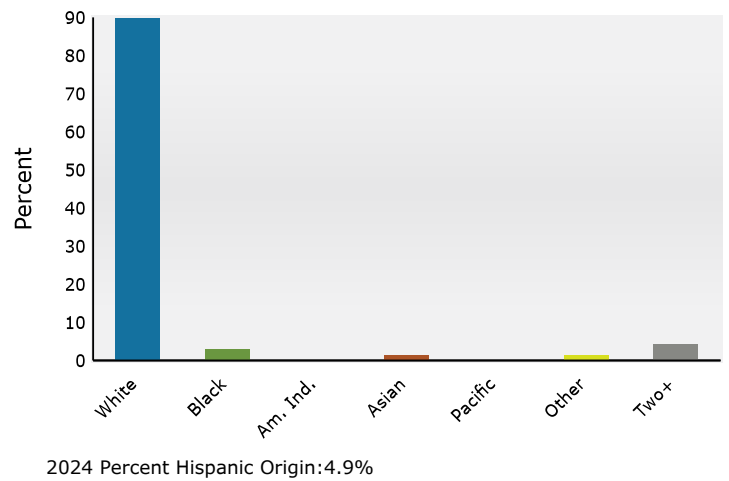
## Population by Age

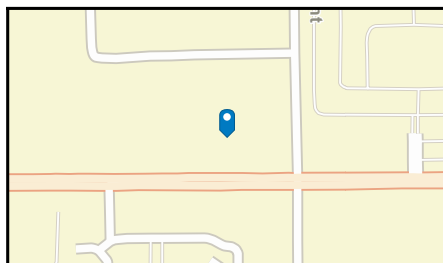
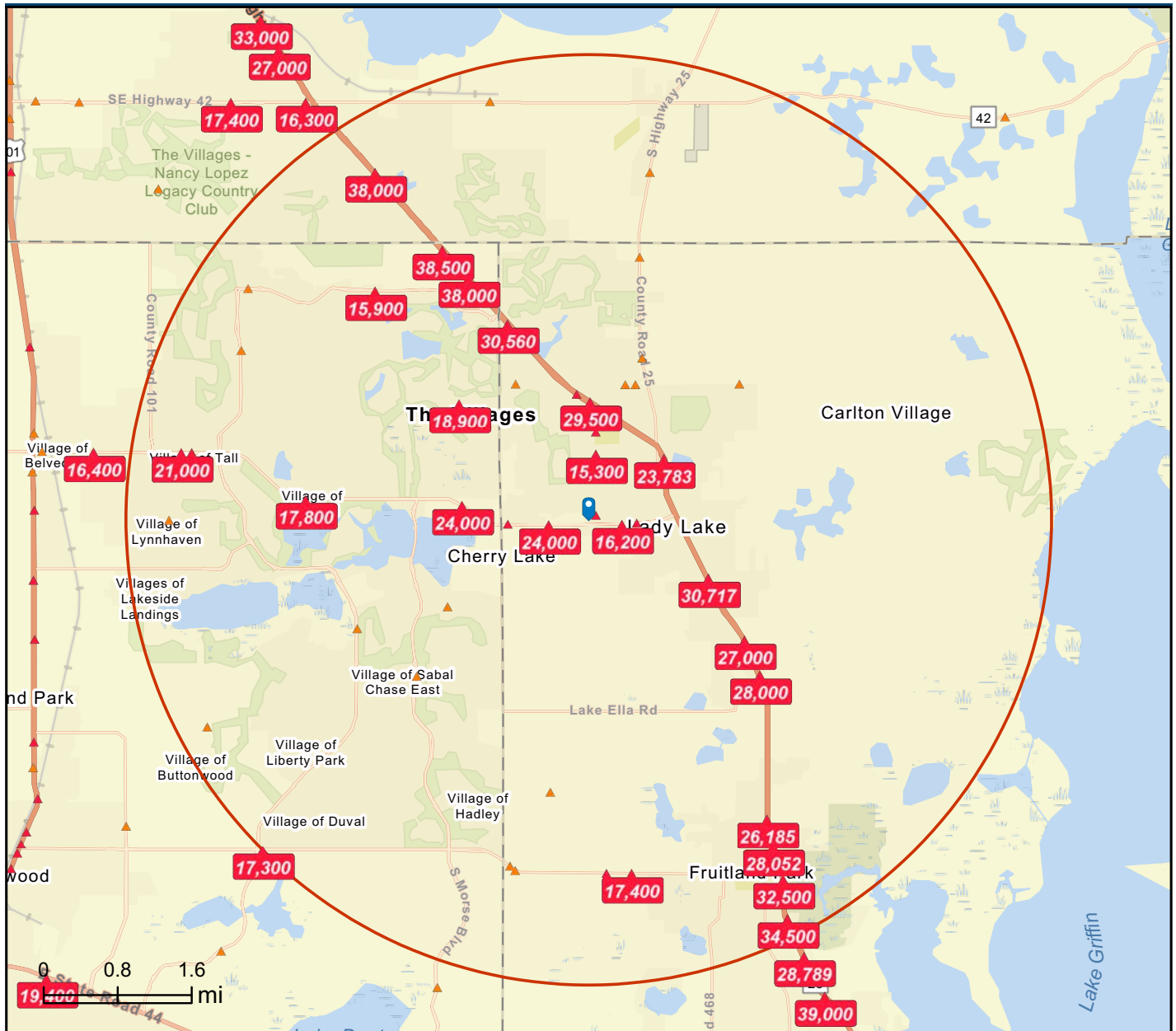

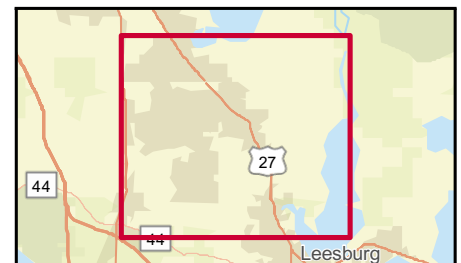
