in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said grantor do hereby grant  
and convey to the said grantees.

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate in the First Ward of the Borough of Montoursville, County of Lycoming and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a post on the east side of an alley running north and south; thence along the east side of said alley northward one hundred sixty-seven (167) feet to a point twenty-five (25) feet south of the line of lot now or formerly of Charles Harding (to a proposed street); thence east fifty-two (52) feet to lot now or formerly of Christian Edler; thence southward along said lot one hundred sixty-five (165) feet to a proposed alley; thence along said proposed alley westward sixty-two (62) feet to the place of beginning. Containing nine thousand four hundred sixty-two (9,462) square feet, more or less.

ALSO BEGINNING at the southeast corner of land now the land described above, and on the north side of Peters Alley; thence along the east line of the land described above, north twenty-two and three-fourths (22-3/4) degrees east one hundred sixty-five (165) feet to a post at the northeast corner of lot now or formerly of John Peters; thence north seventy-three and one-half (73-1/2) degrees west fifty-two (52) feet to a post, the northwest corner of lot now or formerly of John E. Thomas; thence north twenty-six and one-half (26-1/2) degrees east twenty-five (25) feet to a post; thence along land now or formerly of Charles Harding south seventy-
