








FLOOR PLAN

TOURISM FACTS

Waikiki is home to an estimated 25,270 residents and supports a civilian labor force of close to 18,000 workers.

The Hawaiian archipelago is one of the most isolated land masses in the world and lies 2,400 miles from the west coast of the U.S. continent. Honolulu, the State capital, is located on the island of Oahu, with just under one million residents. Hawaii's approximately 1.4 million residents are joined each year by about 10.42 million visitors who enjoy the State's pleasant climate, famous beaches, surf, active volcanoes and Polynesian cultural heritage.

In 2019, pre-Covid Oahu recorded visitor spending up by 2.8% to 8.19 billion in sales. The Chinese, Korean, and Japanese visitors boast the highest per person per day spending and play a large part of Kalakaua Avenue's high ranking in the U.S. for retail sales and landlord rents. On average, there are approximately 250,000 tourists a day in Hawaii.


