Grand open hall, balcony gallery, stage, side lawn with vintage stone benches. Rich history **Ideal for event venue, arts, gallery, museum, or boutique offices** **Sold as-is—ready for restoration.**

- **Setting:** Directly opposite **Mary Willis Library** (GA's first free public library); walkable to the Square. Historic downtown Washington, Ga.

- **Architecture:** Towered entry, arched windows, columned portico; **grand hall + balcony gallery + stage**
